

Tuesday, Dec 19th
At this day strong breezes from the North inclining
East with rain took in the night sails stood
Set one sail in night to the foreward
Lat 41 indiff. Obs 20 10

Wednesday, Dec 20th
Begins with strong breezes from the East and
Cloudy with fine rain stayed at 9 AM set the
main top of 3rd sail middle part strong breeze
with rain at 9 AM heavy gale from ESE
furlled all sails but Close Reefed main top
sail & 3rd top mast stay sail ends with heavy
gale and thick rainy weather. The ship being
to heading to the SE sent down the fore top of 3rd and
main top sail

Thursday, Dec 21st
Begins with heavy gale from the SE and
rain going to heading ESE middle part
weather much the same wind North heading
at 4 AM had a heavy squall from the
North at 4 AM the clouds some broken then
SE and set the fore sail and Close Reefed
3rd top sail
Lat 28 10 Long 40 30

Friday, Dec 22nd
Begins with strong breezes from the NW W
inclining Westward turned out the reefs and set
the courses at 4 PM heavy gale from NW W
and Clear with a tempestuous swell bearing
from NW W at 9 PM stayed East middle
part strong wind and a heavy sea saw
a sail steering SE at 5 AM more squalls
with a heavy swell made sail set the 3rd
mast standing sail and sent up the 2nd top
gallant yard
Lat 28 55 Long 39 55

Saturday, Dec 23rd
Begins with light winds from the NW W
begin the reefing sail and stand SE
squall and later part light winds from
the West with a heavy swell
Lat 29 21 Long 40 30

Sunday, Dec 24th
Begins with light winds from the West and
fine weather reached to the day at 8 AM the
winds inclining Southward tucked to the West and
set the 3rd top of 3rd sail middle and latter part
fine weather
Lat 29 51 Long 41 20

Monday, Dec 25th
Begins with fine breezes from SE and
Cloudy steering SE under all sail middle part
weather much the same latter part squalls East
and rising clouds stayed at 11 AM
Lat 31 20 Long 43 20

Tuesday, Dec 26th
Begins with fine breezes from the East
and rising clouds stayed at 11 AM saw porpoise, sun
fish and turtle at 7 PM sailed Reefed the top sails
and furlled the main sail steered NW W by compass
at 11 AM set the main top of 3rd sail saw some
porpoise ends with strong breezes from ESE
and rising clouds
Lat 32 44 Long 46 00

Wednesday, Dec 27th
Begins with strong breezes from SE and
at 7 PM Close Reefed the top sails and furlled
the heading to the NW W at 9 AM wind from
the SE and Clear a heavy swell bearing from
the East the ship lying had now ship to the
SE strong winds and Clear through the night
at day light more moderate wind to the NW W
and set the 3rd top and courses and turned out one
sail from the top sails at 11 AM increasing gale
and Clear Close Reefed the fore top sail back in the
3rd and main sail
Lat 32 50 Long 47 20

Thursday, Dec 28th
Begins with strong breezes from the SE and
rising clouds stayed at 11 AM strong gale
and Cloudy with a heavy sea bore to anchor at
Close Reefed main top sail heading to the ESE
middle part weather much the same at day light
weather to the NW W and set Close Reefed top
sails and courses ends with strong breezes and
rising clouds
