

Friday Dec 29th
All this day heavy gales from the East
with rain at sunset fore & under close reefed
main top sail heading to the S & East at day
light set close reefed fore top and fore sail

Saturday Dec 30th
Began with strong wind from the East &
rain headed S & at 3 PM increasing gale from
the W & and a large sea took in the fore sail
and fore top sail headed E & at 4 PM increasing
gale waving from East to W with rain took in
the waist boat and sent down the fore top 40
yard and some lower top to head the sea
at 5 AM some broken wind N & S set fore sail
and close reefed fore top sail & kept the sail

Sunday Dec 31st
Began with strong breeze from the West
and a large sea headed E & under close reefed
top sails the weather took and being middle
part weather much the same latter part
strong breeze from the West and squally stored
East

Monday Jan 1st
All this day heavy gale from the West inclining
Southerly Sailed East Lat 32 11

Tuesday Jan 2nd
All this day heavy gale from the South
inclining Easterly with rain strong W & East
under double reefed top sails Lat 31 45 long 42 30

Wednesday Jan 3rd
Began with strong breeze from the S inclining
Easterly with squally rain set the main sail
and set reefed top sail headed W & at 4 PM
part weather much the same latter part strong
breeze from E & and broken clouds made
at sail Lat 31 46 long 46 30

Thursday Jan 4th
All this day strong breeze from E & with
foggy clouds at 4 PM headed to the S & E
Employed heating fresh water and filling
some casks with salt water for Ballast
Lat 31 14 long 38 30

Friday Jan 5th
All this day strong breeze from E & and
foggy clouds strong S & East up to 9 PM gale
past and put out the waist boat Lat 30 52
long 36 45

Saturday Jan 6th
All this day strong breeze from the E & and
foggy clouds strong S & East the fore top
sail Lat 32 15 long 31 15

Sunday Jan 7th
Began with fine breeze from the E & headed
S & middle and latter part strong breeze from
the W & and clear stored E & Lat 33 05 long 32 10

Monday Jan 8th
All this day strong winds from the North and
clear stored E & under double reefed top sails
Lat 33 11 long 28 00

Tuesday Jan 9th
All this day strong winds from the West and
clear stored E & Lat 33 18 long 25 00

Wednesday Jan 10th
Began with strong winds from the North and
clear stored E & middle part strong breeze
and clear. Ends with strong winds from the
West and heavy rain on sail in sight

Thursday Jan 11th
Began with strong winds from the S inclining
Southerly stored E & middle part strong winds
from the North with rain latter part
strong winds from S & and rain

Friday Jan 12th
All this day strong breeze from the S & E
with rain stored W & E

Saturday Jan 13th
Began with strong breeze from E & and
squally at 2 PM the wind backed to the West
in a squall and died away middle part light
air from the W & and calm ends with light
air from the North and clear Lat 31 14 long
