

Sunday Jan 14th
Begins with light variable winds and calm
steered S by E latter part light winds from the
North and fine weather Lat 31 12

Monday Jan 15th
Begins with light winds from the North
and squally appearance at 2 PM the winds
shifted to the S by E middle and
latter part variable winds and squalls of rain
Lat 31 01 long 17 11

Tuesday Jan 16th
Begins with variable winds and squalls of rain
steered different courses at 5 PM sent out boat
on board of a Swedish whaler, apparently
in distress having large spar lashed up to support
her mainmast over her larger ship in sight steering
to the S at night put up many guns for cutting
the whaler and which kept latter part strong
breezes from the East and falling clouds
Lat 31 30 long 17 11

Wednesday Jan 17th
Begins with strong winds from the East inclining
Northerly headed to the S by E in sight of the whaler
steamed middle part strong breezes from the N by E
steered S by E latter part strong winds from the N by E
and falling clouds one sail in sight Lat 32 12

Thursday Jan 18th
Begins with strong winds from the North
with rain steered S by E middle part strong
winds from the North steered S by E at day light
strong winds took in the main top of sail
and double reefed the top sails Lat 31 14 long 11 11

Friday Jan 19th
Begins with strong breezes from the North
and cloudy steered S by E middle part strong
latter part strong breezes from the West with rain

Saturday Jan 20th
Begins with moderate gale from the West inclining
Southward steered N by E middle and latter part variable
winds and squally with heavy swell bearing from the N
made all sail Lat 28 10 long 8 40

Sunday Jan 21st
First part light airs from the West and calm
middle part light winds from the South and fine
weather steered S by E latter part light winds
from the S and fine weather Lat 25 51 long 8 07

Monday Jan 22nd
Begins with light winds from the South and
East and fine weather steered S by E middle part
wind inclining Easterly latter part strong breezes
from the S by E inclining Easterly Lat 25 40 long 7 06

Tuesday Jan 23rd
Begins with strong breezes from the East
and squally headed to the S at 3 PM took in
the light sails middle part much the same
latter part light winds from the S by E and
fine weather Lat 23 57 long 7 06

Wednesday Jan 24th
Begins with light winds from the S by E
headed to the S by E middle and latter part fine
weather made all sail Lat 24 40 long 5 58

Thursday Jan 25th
Begins with light winds from the East
inclining Southward at 5 PM headed to the
N by E latter part strong breezes from the S by E
and falling clouds Lat 23 55 long 5 16

Friday Jan 26th
Begins with strong S by E trade and falling
clouds steered steered S by E middle and latter
part weather much the same at 5 PM steered
N by E saw porpoises Lat 22 15 long 5 21

Saturday Jan 27th
all this day light winds from the S by E and calm
steered N by E saw Porpoises and British Squid

Sunday Jan 28th
all this day light winds from the S by E and
squally headed to the S by E under short sail
