

Monday Feb 12th
Begins with light trades and fine weather
headed W by N. falling part cloudy Steered W by N
one sail in sight Steering W by N Ends with
light trades and cloudy Steered W by N
the Barque Almal in sight Steering West

Tuesday Feb 13th
all this day light trades and passing clouds
Steered W by N. put out the fore top sail and re-
paired it and bent it. Lat 16 05 long 15 00

Wednesday Feb 14th
Begins with fine trades and passing
clouds Steered West at 2 PM. Shortened sail and
luffed to the wind middle part squally at day
light made sail and Steered West at 10 PM. Steered
W by N. Lat 16 40 long 8 20

Thursday Feb 15th
Begins with light trades and passing clouds
Steered W by N at 4 o'clock in the morning. At 4 PM. sail
middle part squally later part strong trade
and passing squally employed in repairing the old
top sail and bent the new one and Steered it W by N
Lat 16 05 long 9 50

Friday Feb 16th
Begins with strong trade and fine weather
steered W by N. finished the old top sail and
bent it. Saw large schools of flying fish middle
part fine later part more moderate. Bent the
top. L.P. Island Steading. Spent the day there
Lat 12 50 long 11 20

All this day light trades and fine weather.
Steered North by Compass. Lat 16 00 long 12 00

Saturday Feb 17th
all this day fine trades and pleasant weather
Steered North by Compass. Lat 16 55 long 13 10

Sunday Feb 18th
Begins with fine trades and pleasant weather
steered W by N at 4 PM. Saw a small island
about 10 miles off at 1 PM. passed to the westward
of it at day light the pole just in sight at dawn
50 8.30

Tuesday Feb 20th
all this day light trades and fine weather. Steered
W by N by Compass. Saw great many flying fish
Lat 16 45 long 14 00

Wednesday Feb 21st
Begins with fine trades and squally
weather. Steered W by N at 2 PM. Squally with
heavy Rain middle part fine trades and the fore
later part cloudy

Thursday Feb 22nd
all this day fine trades and passing clouds
Steered W by N by Compass. Lat 16 00 long 13 00

Friday Feb 23rd
all this day fine trades and passing squalls
Steered W by N by Compass. Saw great schools of flying fish

Saturday Feb 24th
all this day moderate trades and squally
Steered W by N. Saw some sharks. Lat 16 50 long 15 00

Sunday Feb 25th
all this day light winds from the S by E and
squally with Rain. Steered North by Compass
Lat 16 50 North

Monday Feb 26th
all this day light air from the S by E at 6 AM. Saw
Sperm whale and finback. Lat 16 00 long 15 00



Tuesday Feb 27th
Begins with light variable winds and squally
cut in the night. Saw some flying squid
middle and later part squally. Lat 16 45

Wednesday Feb 28th
all this day light variable winds and calm
Employed Boilering. Saw some white squids

Thursday March 1st
all this day light E. by N. winds and calm. Saw
porpoises and schools of small fish. finished
boilering. Strong current setting S. Lat 16 45 long 17 00
