all this day strong trade and squally
steered W by N several sails in sight found
North Latitude 14 N Long 49 30

Sunday March 18th
all this day fine trade and some squally
steered W by N made all sail Lat 14 25
Long 52 40

Monday March 19th
all this day fine trade and some squally
steered W by N several sails in sight found
North Latitude 15 10 Long 53 30

Tuesday March 20th
all this day squally steered S by W
prosperous Latitude 11 22 Long

Wednesday March 21st
all this day strong trade and squally
steered W by N at 11 AM they had sight of day
light saw Dominica the middle of it
steering N by E 10 miles at 1 PM they came
to anchor in Prince Rupert bay found lying
near the barque Cray left Capt Cornish 9 Mon
got no sperm from him. At 1 PM strong
breeze and squally got off one half of water
these Remarks contain 20 hours

Thursday March 22nd
all this day strong trade and squally
got off wood water and Ballast and towing the
net on deck

Friday March 23rd
all this day strong trade and squally
got off some Ballast and Water

Saturday
all this day strong trade and squally
got off some Kiverin

Sunday March 24th
this day some squally one watch on shore
at night found two men missing

Monday March 25th
this day some squally one watch on shore
the other getting off wood and water at night
found another man missing

Tuesday March 26th
this day fine weather got off some Ballast and
Kiverin at night squally two men missing

Wednesday March 27th
this day strong trade and fine weather caught
a small hump back whale at 9 PM got
under way and steered out to the W by N at
11 PM strong breeze from the East Roped the
top sails in a calm quadruple in sight

Thursday March 28th
begins with light fine from the S by E
steered W by N at 1 PM set the top
sails from 9 AM to 12 PM making calm faster
from East side began these Remarks contain
12 hours

Friday March 29th
most part calm several sails in sight
at 4 PM strong trade steered W by N 10 miles
back strong trade Roped several small Kiverins
W by N at 11 PM set more moderate one at 1 PM
in sight steering W by N Lat 11 31

Saturday March 30th
begins with moderate trade and fine weather
sailed and the whole made three 1/2 days W by N
under all sail. Several sails in sight at 11
PM took in sail and lay to till morning
at day light made sail & steered in for the
bay at 2 PM came to anchor in the Port of
St Thomas from 12 miles to 10 PM fine weather
these Remarks contain 35 hours

Sunday March 31st
all this day fine weather one watch on
shore
