

Monday April 1st
all this day Employed getting the oil
Ready to ship

Tuesday April 2nd
this day some squally but one breeze
and ship at 11 o'clock of spirit oil was hoisted
the schooner Indus of West Port sailed

Wednesday April 3rd
this day some squally one watch on
shore the other employed getting off provisions

Thursday April 4th
all this day light trades and fine weather
one watch on shore the other employed
sailing and steaming away the provisions

Friday April 5th
this day some squally one watch on
shore the other sailing this day discharge
two men one run away

Saturday April 6th
this day light trades and fine weather
finished painting employed shipping men
and getting ready for sea the day the
Largest of Boston Commerce departed

Sunday April 7th
all this day light trades and fine weather
hoisted out along side the crew left

Monday April 8th
at 4 am went on shore to the runaway
man and took him on board got under
way and stood out Steered N by E
these Remarks contain but no hours

Tuesday April 9th
all this day fine trades breeze with a long
shore of West Port at night took in
sail and lay to for the night at day
light made sail concerning the West Port
General sail in sight

Wednesday April 10th
beginning with strong breeze and some
squally steered to the N by E Port of Boston
sailed past wind from the North and
sailed put one keel in the top sail made
several tacks working to the North
Sailed 12 44

Thursday April 11th
beginning with strong breeze and some
squally steered N by E with port struck
with lightning and then port was struck
the wind E by S turned off the keels
Sailed 20 44

Friday April 12th
all this day strong trades and squally
steered N by E two sails in sight

Saturday April 13th
this day strong trades and some
squally at night kept the top sail
