All this day strong trade with rain
Steered N W

Monday April 12th
All this day fine trade with heavy
swell heaving from the N E
Lat 23 55 long 69 30

Tuesday April 13th
All this day moderate trade and
fine weather Steered N W turned out
the reefes and set the main top G
Sail and flying jib
Lat 25 25 long 71 30

Wednesday April 14th
All this day moderate winds from the West
and pleasant Steered to the North & West under
all sail two sails in sight to the Westward
the watch employed Repairing the main
sail
Lat 25 32 long 72 50

Thursday April 15th
All this day light winds from the East
and fine light Steered N W the watch
Employed Repairing the fore top sail
Lat 25 14 long 74 22

Friday April 16th
Begins with light wind from the East
and fine weather Steered N W latter part
light wind from the Southward set the
new main sail and bent the old one
Lat 25 43 long 75 00

Saturday April 17th
Begins with light winds from the South
West headed N W middle part fine breeze
from the S W took in the light sails and
hauled up the courses at day light set the
courses and main top G S Sails Several
sails in sight Bunch Southward
Lat 25 35
Long 76 01

Sunday April 22nd
All this day light winds from the N W
and fine weather headed N W under
all sail
Lat 28 52 long 78 18

Monday April 23rd
Begins with light winds from the N W and
specially appearances in the West at 4 PM
heavy squalls from the North with thunder
and lightning middle part more moderate
at day light made sail specially appearance
in the West at 7 PM heavy squalls from the
N W with thunder and lightning Close Reefs
the top sails took in the jib and fore sails
and Steered S by E under with thick weather

Tuesday April 24th
Begins with moderate gales from the
N W increasing Easterly and specially appearance
at 7 PM heavy squalls from the East with
thunder and lightning fore to heading to
the West under Close Reefs main top sail
and fore mast stay top middle squalls
with thunder and lightning at day light
were ship to the West and set Close Reefs
top sails and fore sail one sail in sight Steered
by the wind to the Southward East under
Close sail

Wednesday April 25th
Begins with strong gales from the East &
Coarse Steered North under all sail at
daylight took in all sail to Close Reefs
top sail & fore top mast stay sail and
fore top square made sail with heavy sea
at daylight set double Reefs top sails and
courses one sailing off to the Southward
at 7 more ship to the S Lat 29 22
Long 77 45

Thursday April 26th
All this day moderate gales from the East
and fine weather Steered N W fore
top to the Southward supposed kept to the S W
but fore top to be a merchant ship supposed
two to the South took in sail middle part fine
at day light made all sail headed by the
wind Lat 28 52
