



Tuesday June 1st

Begins with light winds from the S.W. and fine weather. Headed S.W. at 4 PM. Saw whales toward the north. got two middle parts from within at day light. Cut in the whales and made sail heading S.E. winds S.W. blow some logs and shanty at night. Spoke an English Schooner bound to Bermuda. Lat 31 40 Long 62 50

Wednesday June 2nd

Begins with light winds from S.W. and fine weather. Steered West at hand. Employed in clearing up Deck at 5 PM. Commenced hauling middle part fine within headed S.W. under. Clear. kept later part light winds from S.W. and passing. Clouds finished hauling and cleared up Deck. Lat 31 25 Long 62 43

Thursday June 3rd

Begins with moderate gales from the S.W. and clear. Steered S.W. and made sail at 7 PM. within thick and fine rain. Close reefed the top. Sailed middle part winds from the S.W. and that later part light air and calm. Stowed down the oil. Saw Gampous and later squid. Ends with Clouds within.

Friday June 4th

Begins with light winds from the S.W. and Cloud with some rain. Steered West middle part within much the same later part strong breezes from the S.W. and fine with Steered West very light in light steering. S.W.

Saturday 5th

Begins with strong breezes from S.W. and fine within at 4 PM. took in again top. S.W. sail & flying jib at 9. tacked to the S.W. at 7 PM. Steered East middle part fine within later part strong breezes from the S.W. and passing. Clouds headed. Steered double reef top. Lat 31 02 Long 61 12

Sunday June 6th

Begins with fine breezes from the S.W. & fine within. Steered S.W. at sunset. Shortened sail middle part wind light from the South headed S.W. later part fine clear within. Lat 30 50 Long 60 30

Monday June 11th

Begins with light winds from the South and fine within headed S.W. under short sail. on. Sail in light bound Eastward middle part fine within at day light made all sail. Steered E by N at 9 AM. Spoke the S.W. Dolphin of Boston bound to port. Lat 30 55 Long 59 40

Tuesday June 12th

Begins with fine breezes from S.W. and clear. Steered S.W. under all sail the track. Employed putting down the lower rigging at 5 PM. tacked ship to the S.W. and took in the light sail. fine through the night at day light made all sail headed S.W. three sails in light steering. S.W. Ends with fine breezes from the S.W. headed S.W. Lat 30 50 Long 59 30

Wednesday June 13th

Begins with fine breezes from the S.W. & clear. Steered S.W. under all sail. Several sails in light bound to the North & East at sunset. Clouds reefed the top. Sails made part. Passing. Squall and squall of rain at day light. more ship to the S.W. Ends with fine breezes from the S.W. and fine within. Steered S.W. under all sail. Lat 30 34 Long 58 34

Thursday June 14th

Begins with fine breezes from the S.W. and fine within. Steered S.W. at sunset. Squally appearance took in the light sails middle part within much the same winds. S.W. headed S.W. later part squally two sails in light bound Eastward. Lat 31 34 Long 57 58

Friday June 15th

Begins with strong breezes from the S.W. and squally appearance. Reefed East one sail in light bound Eastward at sunset. took in the top. Sails middle and later part within much the same. Lat 32 02 Long 57 00

Saturday June 16th

At 11 AM. strong breezes from the S.W. & clear. later part. Squally reefed the top. Sails and tacked on the wind to the S.W. Lat 32 00 Long 58 00
