Calms. Steered North. Saw Blackfish. Lowered
the boat got two two other schools in sight
plenty of Porpoises and grampuses in sight.

Saturday June 30th

Begins with light breeze from the East and
at 4 PM spoke the Albatross Richard & Birnie
towing latter part wind W by N and squally. Two
schools in sight sailed out the blackfish at 10 AM.
Saw Blackfish lowered got nothing.

Lat 32 30 Long 50 00

Sunday July 1st

Begins with strong breeze from the West and
squally. Steered N by W at 1 PM. Lowered the boat for
Blackfish. Spoke and drove the Albatross Richard & Birnie
in space of the Blackfish. Middle and latter part strong
breeze from the West. Day headed to the South & East
under close reefed top. Sails one ship in sight steering S by E.

Lat 32 07 Long 49 45

Monday July 2nd

First part strong breeze from the N by W and
squally. Clearances headed to the N by W under short
sail middle and latter part more moderate at day light
made all sail and steered North.

Lat 32 20 Long 49 30

Tuesday July 3rd

Begins with moderate breeze from the N by W
and fine weather. Steered North at sunset. Shortened
sail heading to the N by W. At day light made all sail &
steered S E. Ends with light winds from the West and
fine weather.

Lat 33 07 Long 50 20

Wednesday July 4th

All this day moderate gale and fine weather.
Steered to the North and East one school in sight
to the North.

Lat 33 24 Long 49 30



Thursday July 5th

Begins with moderate gale from the N by W
steering to the N E at 3 PM spoke the brig named of
Wilmington in months out one hundred one tons.
Saw 8 severely whale middle part fine breeze
from the East. Steered S E latter part strong
breezes and cloudy. The Albatross Richard & Birnie
in sight steering the same. Began.

Lat 32 30 Long 48 30

Friday July 6th

Begins with strong breeze from the N by W and
fine weather. Steered S E the Albatross Richard & Birnie
in sight steering the same course at 7 PM. Close
reefed the top sails middle part strong breeze
from the N by W and squally. Clouds headed
S E at day light. Spoke the Albatross Richard & Birnie
Ends with strong breeze from the East and
fine weather one sail in sight at 10 AM.

Long 47 20

Saturday July 7th

Begins with strong breeze from the East
and fine weather. Steered South at sunset. Close
reefed the top sail looking the N by E. Again
sail put back on the wind to the S by W middle part
strong breeze at day light. Squally steering West
one squalling S E in sight steering to the North.

Lat 30 23 Long 40 30

Sunday July 8th

Begins with fine breeze from the East. Steered
N by W made all sail one sail in sight. Began
the North & East at sunset. Close reefed the
top sails furled main and jib under the
last squally latter part fine weather. Saw
sail steering S E.

Lat 31 15 Long

Monday July 9th

Begins with fine breeze from the East and
pleasant headed N by W under close reefed top
sails middle part strong squally at day light
made all sail and good weather. North. Saw
Porpoises and grampuses. Ends with moderate gale
from the East and fine weather.

Lat 31 52 Long 45 45
