 Begins with moderate gales and fine weather. Steered S. by E. wind from N.W. at 4 PM. Squally saw then squied at 7. Saw several to the westward five miles off. midday part moderate & fine made several tacks to the windward later part with much the same made several tacks to the windward saw some then squied two sails in sight bearing Eastward.
 Lat 32 31 Long 48 26

Wednesday July 29th
 Begins with light winds from the N.W. and fine weather. Steered N.W. by W. passed a Clipper ship steering East one more sail in sight steering the same course midday part fine later part strong breezes from the S.W. & squally Steered N.W. by W. saw a wrapping Schooner & a Barque steering to the South & East. Lat 32 24 Long 48 38

Thursday July 30th
 All this day strong winds from the S.W. & squally Steered N.W. by W. saw several sails in sight. Steered different courses. Saw porpoises. Lat 31 24

Friday July 31st
 All this day strong gales from the South & W. and squally spoke the ship Emma C. four months out with the ship. Lat 31 37 Long 48 00

Saturday July 31st
 Begins with strong winds from the S.W. Steered N.W. by W. at 5 PM. double reefed top sails on. Left in sight to the south at 3 were ship made all sail & steered N.W. midday part strong winds from N.W. passed a ship lying two miles off. Kept main top sail at 6. Part the fore top G.P. sail and set it. passed a Schooner under short sail. End with strong winds from the N.W. and squally. Clouds.
 Lat 32 55 Long 48 10

Sunday July 29th
 All this day strong breezes from the S.W. and squally. Steered N.W. by W. under all sail. Spoke 2 sails heading to the North & West under short sail. Lat 34 00 Long 44 00

Monday July 30th
 All this day fine breezes from the S.W. & squally. Steered East. Saw porpoises. Lat 34 58 Long 42 00

Tuesday July 31st
 All this day strong winds from N.W. and squally. Steered N.W. by W. Lat 35 00 Long 40 00

Wednesday
 All this day strong winds from the West and squally. Steered East 2 sails in sight to the West. Lat 35 30 Long 34 20

Thursday Aug 1st
 Begins with strong winds from the West. Steered East any squally at 2 PM. passed a heavy squall from the N.W. with wind & rain took in the top sails and kept the top sail & steering E. & squally through the night at day light strong breeze from the N.W. with a heavy swell made all day. Saw porpoises on sail in sight steering East. Lat 37 00 or 38 N Long 32 30 W

Friday Aug 2nd
 Begins with strong winds from N.W. by W. & squally. Steered E. & made part winds light breeze from the N.W. and cloudy. Steered N.W. by W. later part light winds from the West and squally. Clouds. Steered E. & saw plenty of porpoises and then kept one sail in sight to the West. Lat 38 22 Long 30 04

Saturday Aug 3rd
 Begins with light winds from the West. Steered E. & made part thick short sail later part strong breezes and cloudy. Came to anchor in Bay of and landed the second mate & such.
