Monday Oct 8th

All this day light breeze from the East and Calms at 3 PM saw whales lowered the Boats and chased but did not overtake them at day light saw whales lowered the boats got one at 9 AM took him along side and cut him in the 1st messenger in light boiling



Tuesday Oct 9th

Begins with light winds from the East and fine weather Employed Boiling

Wednesday Oct 10th

All this day light breeze and Calms at 3 PM saw whales lowered the Boats got 3



at 7 AM saw whales lowered got two



Thursday Oct 11th

All this day light breeze from the South & East and Calms Cut in the whale close in with the land

Friday Oct 12th

All this day light variable winds and Calms Employed Boiling spoke the 1st Alexander of Provincetown

Saturday Oct 13th

All this day light variable winds and Calms Employed Boiling and Hauling down the 1st spoke the 1st Alexander of Provincetown

Sunday Oct 14th

All this day light winds from the East and fine weather finished boiling

Monday Oct 15th

All this day light breeze and fine weather. Hauled down the oil

Tuesday Oct 16th

All this day fine breeze and pleasant weather through the Coast at 3 AM packed molasses in for barrels at day light saw whale along side the 1st spoke the 1st Alexander of Provincetown got three and took them along side



Wednesday Oct 17th

All this day light breeze from the East Cut in the whale and commenced boiling

Thursday Oct 18th

Begins with light breeze and squally appearance at 5 PM saw whale did not take it along side on account of bad weather commencing on mid part of breeze wind and squally with thunder and lightning later part better on with the land
