

Friday Oct 18th
All this day strong trade and it being sea
throughout in light and one schooner at
10⁰⁰ run in and made it lay to the south
of jacomar finished boiling and commencing
showing down

Saturday Oct 20th
Began with strong trade and fresh smoke
weather laying under the lee of jacomar
showing down the oil and sent the oil for
top salt

Sunday Oct 21st
All this day light trade and it being smooth
heaving from the NE six whales in sight

Monday Oct 22nd
All this day light air and calm several
sails in sight cruising

Tuesday Oct 23rd
All this day light air from the N and calm
five whales in sight saw finbacks & porpoises
jacomar in sight did not leave

Wednesday Oct 24th
Began with fresh trade strong in fore
the Straits at 9⁰⁰ AM spoke the sea flower
of New Bedford and Spitz Lewis Bruce
Provincetown middle part strong breeze
at 9⁰⁰ AM spoke the Sch. Alexander of Provincetown
Dues with strong wind and it being sea
run down under the lee of jacomar
found seven seals of whales had run
in to make a lot

Thursday Oct 25th
All this day strong trade and it being large
sea

Friday Oct 26th
Began with strong trade with it high
sea heading off and in off Point jacomar
saw finbacks four whales in sight
cruising

Saturday Oct 27th
All this day strong trade and it being sea
saw finbacks four whales in sight cruising
under short sail caught it passing

Sunday Oct 28th
All this day strong breeze and squally
kept close in sight the lee of the land under
close reefed top sails on Schooner and Barque
in sight

Monday Oct 29th
Began with strong breeze from the North
and squally lay close in with the land
under close reefed top sails middle
part more moderate at daylight made some
more sail heading to the East four sails in sight

Tuesday Oct 30th
All this day strong winds from the NE and
raining clouds four whales in sight cruising

Wednesday Oct 31st
Began with strong winds from the NE
and cloudy middle part under short sail
latter part more moderate with squalls
large headed in for jacomar saw plenty
calm and jacob

Thursday Nov 1st
Began with fine breeze from the NE
and some squalls of fair four whales
in sight middle and latter part light winds
from the North & squally three whales in sight
saw some porpoises about Point jacomar
Bore N W Dist 3 miles

Friday Nov 2nd
First part calm and squally appearance
middle and latter part light variable winds
and calm several whales in sight South & East
& a few seals of jacomar in sight bound South
land in sight bearing North West and the
East bearing SE saw two fishermen
to anchor on the Banks Lat 23 42
