

Brig Ocean of Sandwich

Saturday Nov 3rd

Begins with light trade and plebs ant
steers N by W. middle part fine pleasant
within. Ends with light winds from the East
and fine. Steers North ventures in light
beating North

Sunday Nov 4th

Begins with fine breezes from the East
and pleasant. Steers in for the land middle
and later part moderate heading in for the
land. Caught 4 porpoises

Monday Nov 5th

Begins with fine breezes from the East
middle. Steers at last to the N. E. along shore
middle part cloudy. Later part light air
and Calms. Caught 4 porpoises. Point Jacoman
bore N. W. dist 3 leagues

Tuesday Nov 6th

Begins with light air from the East & cloudy
later part breezy and fair. middle part cloudy
later part wind from the East and rain
one Barque and Schooner in sight

Wednesday Nov 7th

Begins with light winds from the East
inclining southerly. Steers to the N. E.
middle part winds and weather mostly the
same. at 9 AM saw the Pt. Rotterdam
in chase of whale at 10 lowered our boat
got one. She got nothing
Ends with fine breeze from
the S. E. the Captain took keep bore North
dist 3 leagues 3 barques & one Schooner in sight

Thursday Nov 8th

Begins with fine breeze from the S. E.
Cut in the water middle part light wind
from the N. E. and fine weather. Employed
Bailing later part light air from the
N. E. and Calms. Steers in for Allegreanza

Cruising off Lancote 1851

Friday Nov 9th

Begins with light air from the N. E. Steers
in toward Allegreanza at 10 Steers East between
Allegreanza and Pt. Clara. Later part light winds
from the West N. E. Steers along shore of point
to the South and West

Saturday Nov 10th

all this day light air and Calms Steers to
the S. E.

Sunday Nov 11th

all this day light winds from the North &
West Steers to the S. W. along shore of Ventura

Monday Nov 12th

all this day light wind from the
North with passing squalls of rain at 3 PM
Spoke the S. S. Chase of Beverly middle
and later part weather much the same
Point Jacoman bore N. W. dist 6 miles

Tuesday November 13th

all this day light air and Calms at 3 PM
Spoke the Mepengre of Salem middle
part fine weather later part light winds
from the North and squally appearances

Wednesday Nov 14th

Begins with strong breezes from the South
Steers North at 3 PM saw Blackfish
lancers the boat got one
was fore West dist 4 miles
part strong breeze from the S. W. air clear
headed N. W. W. under close reefed top sails
at 7 PM Allegreanza bore South dist 10 leagues
at 10 PM the vessel shifted suddenly to the West
with heavy rain upon ship to the S. W. and
sent down the Kougat yard

Thursday Nov 15th

Begins with heavy gales from the West and
cloudy at 2 PM Steers S. E. for Allegreanza
middle part strong breeze lay under the lee of Lancote
later part strong winds from the East headed to the S. E.
Backed out the Blackfish
