

Tuesday Nov 27th
This day the winds light from land
and the fog set up to from Island San
Nothing but locked in clouds.

Wednesday Nov 28th
All this day fine breeze from the S W
with some swell running in.

Thursday Nov 29th
Begins with strong breezes from the S W
and fine weather middle part foggy and
heavy swell heaving in at 3 PM got very
away and stood out in PM the clouds
at 5 PM light breeze from the S W and
a heavy swell heaving from the W W
at day light made some sail the clouds
in sight at 10 AM saw at 11 AM the
winds from the S W and South. Close Reef
the fore top sail took in the Coopers jib
and the sail then Remarks Captain Thistle
Sail Ho.

Friday Dec 1st the Sea became
Begins with strong gales from the S W
and squally with it heavy sea headed
W W under short sail middle part strong
winds and squally at 4 PM the wind inclining
westerly were ship to the South & West one
sail off our weather beam. Strong & light
at day light strong gale from the S W and
heavy squally waves ship to the W W at
heavy sea heaving from the S W at 4 PM
the wind shifted to the W W W were ship
to the South West at 10 PM the Coopers

All this day strong winds from W V W and
fair headed North at 5 AM were ship to
the S W

Sunday Dec 3rd
Begins with light winds from the West
and fine weather. Headed S W under short
sail at heavy swell heaving from the West
at 3 PM passed large tide ship saw it to be
Shark in eye of the sun middle part moderate
gale from the West headed W W at day light
made all sail two sails in sight at 4 PM looked
to the South and West Lat obs 25 53 S

Monday Dec 4th
Begins with moderate gale from the S W
and fine weather 2 sails in sight at 1 PM
tacked to the South & W at 3 PM stood out
at 5 PM Boarded a Spanish fisherman saying
at anchor on the edge of the Banks and
got some fish middle part headed W W
under short sail at day light strong breeze
from the S W and squally one sail in
sight. Steaming W W W Lat obs 24 03 Long 17 22

Tuesday Dec 5th
Begins with strong breezes from the S W and
cloudy headed W W under Close Reef. Top
sail middle part wind light and squally
later part strong wind from the South
and fine fair headed S W Lat obs 24 10 Long 16 57

Wednesday Dec 6th
Begins with strong winds from the S W and
fair headed S W under Close Reef. Top
sail in sight. Steaming W W at 4 PM
4 sails in sight. Steaming against Coopers
middle part fine breezes from the S W and
Clear at 1 PM were ship to the W W W at day
light saw ship to the South & East at day
light saw ship made through fog to
the South and West along shore Lat obs 23 45

Thursday Dec 7th
Begins with light winds from the S W and
heavy swell heaving from the W W middle
part strong breezes and fine fair later part
light winds from the South West headed
South and in sight Lat obs 23 53
