Sunday Dec 9th

First part light winds from the W & W by N
at 1 PM the one sail in sight to the
South at 2 PM the other sail headed
West middle part light airs from the South at
3 PM were ship to the E & at day light
saw the land latter part light air from
the W & land Calm headed to the South
Lat 23 25 North

Monday Dec 10th

First part light winds from the North & West
at 3 PM saw ships at anchor in
Cintra Bay at 4 PM Run in and anchored
found lying there the ships Spanish Brig
and John Elizabeth three others sail
in the South part of the Bay from 10
to 11 PM wind light from W & W and
lightning in the East these remarks
commence at 11 PM in vision and end at
midnight Calms but in hours to commence
barometer account

in search of whale

Saturday Dec 15th

All this day light trade and fine weather at
4 PM the Brig Louis Bruch came in

Sunday Dec 16th

All this day light trade and fine weather
Chased a Wright whale at 2 PM the
weather fair came in and anchored

Monday Dec 17th

All this day fine trade and pleasant

Tuesday Dec 18th

All this day trade moderate and with fine

Wednesday Dec 19th

First part light winds from the East and
fine weather middle part Calm at 4 PM
light winds from the West and foggy
at 7 PM the wind shifted to the S & E with
heavy squalls at 11 PM the friends
anchored End with strong trade and
cloudy
