Begins with fine trade with an overcast middle and later part fine weather the Boat Cruising the Bay.

All this day fresh trade and clear got two whales.

All this day fine trade and pleasant saw nothing.

All this day moderate and fine.

Friday Feb 15th

All this day fine weather.

Saturday Feb 16th

This day strong trade the weather thick and smoky saw one whale.

Sunday Feb 17th

This day strong trade and clear.

Monday Feb 18th

Strong trade and clear.

All this day strong trade got one whale.
