got one whale and sunk him

Monday Feb 25th
all this day strong trades and fine
weather - killed the whale up and cut
it in

Tuesday Feb 26th
all this day moderate trades and fine
weather Employed Baiting Saw
whales lowered got nothing

Wednesday Feb 27th
all this day fresh trades finished Baiting

Thursday Feb 28th
this day fresh trades and clear weather

Friday Feb 29th
all this day fine weather the
Master of the Baranes came in

Saturday March 1st
all this day moderate trades and clear
saw whale

Sunday March 2nd
all this day moderate trades and fine
got a whale and sunk him

Monday March 3rd
all this day light winds and fine weather
saw a whale chased but got nothing

Tuesday March 4th
all this day fine weather - killed up the
whale and cut it in

Wednesday March 5th
all this day light winds and fine weather
saw a whale chased got nothing

Thursday March 6th
all this day light winds from the South
with a heavy South breeze in from
Sea at 2 AM finished Baiting

Friday March 7th
all this day light trades and a heavy
South breeze in from Sea latter part
squally

Saturday March 8th
Began with light winds from the East
lowered and took a hook Rained the
day made part of the night with a heavy
dew at 3 PM light trades got under way
and steered to the South & West

Sunday March 9th
Began with fine breezes from the
West & North West under short sails then
Remarks - commenced at 10 AM and ended
at 10 o'clock and continued but in haste
to Commence Sea Account
