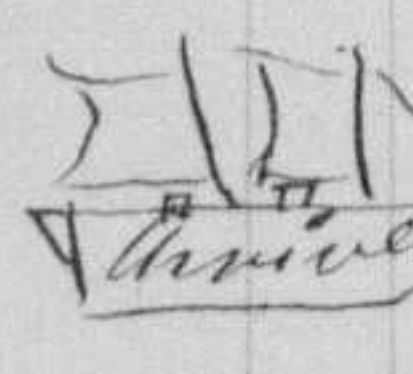


Sunday May <sup>the</sup> 6 1860
