Tuesday August 1860
 this day begins with late breeze
 from West saw ship Scotland
 Middle part fine weather
 at 11 finished hauling Oil
 Latter part fine breeze S.W.
 all hands employed cooping
 Oil to put on board ship
 Scotland so ends this day
 Lat 44 54 N Long 29 39 W

Wednesday August 1860
 this day begins with fine breeze
 from W at 6 put on board ship
 Scotland 13 Cask Oil
 Middle part fresh breeze wind
 Oil 16 13 Latter fresh breeze S.W.
 Squalls rain set 8 Cask
 down blubber room so ends
 Lat 45 16 N Long 30 28 W

Thursday August 1860
 this day begins with fresh breeze
 from South Squally foggy
 Middle part much the same
 heading & wind ESE
 at 11 morning heard whales spouting
 at 12 saw them going off
 at 14 loan chased them til 12 m
 came on board whale so ends
 Lat 45 01 N Long 31 00 W

Friday August 1860
 this day begins with fine breeze
 from ESE at 2 saw whales at 2 20
 loaded Bouter at 3 parted & labored
 at 6 took him long side
 Middle part fine weather watch
 employed running down Oil
 Latter part calm at 5 hooked on
 the whale at 12 we finished Body
 so ends Scotland in site so ends
 Lat 44 54 N Long 30 14 W

Saturday August 1860
 this day begins with calm employed
 hauling case clearing up decks
 Middle Latter calm all hands employed
 hauling Oil saw ship Scotland
 Lat 44 49 N Long 30 44 W

Sunday August 1860
 this day begins with late breeze
 Calm Middle Latter calm all
 hands employed hauling Oil
 Saw 3 sailers so ends this day
 Lat 44 43 N Long 30 42 W

Monday August 1860
 this day begins with late breeze
 Calm saw whaling bark
 Middle part fine weather
 Latter late breeze west all
 hands employed hauling Oil
 at 11 finished hauling
 Oil commence storing
 down Oil after haul on the
 Galleyboard haul side so ends
 Lat 44 25 N Long 31 16 W
