this day begins with fine breeze
steer W Middle part steer SE
Gutter S W South
Lat 06 09 26 at 10 am

Wednesday February the 13 1861
this day begins with fresh breeze
& heading W Middle Gutter
same under short sail
Lat 06 10 34 at 10 am

Thursday February the 14 1861
this day fresh breeze & E night
Middle Gutter same heading W
Lat 06 11 53 at 10 am

Thursday February the 15 1861
this day fresh trade night
heading W both by the winds under
short sail saw Humpbacks
Lat 06 12 48 at 10 am

Friday February the 16 1861
this day fresh trade night weather
Middle Gutter same steer
W by S south
Lat 06 12 25 at 10 am

Saturday February the 17 1861
this day begins with strong trade
night weather Middle Gutter same
steer West south single reefed
Lat 06 13 28 at 10 am

Monday February the 18 1861
this day begins with fresh gales
night Middle Gutter same
Lat 06 13 28 at 10 am

Tuesday February the 19 1861
this day fresh gales & E night
Middle part the same short sail
by the wind for the night
at morning saw land Barbados
Capt Off at 9 came to anchor
off the town South

Saturday February the 24 1861
at 6 AM took anchor from Barbados
steer by the wind W by N
Middle Gutter fresh breeze night
single reefed top sail, saw
Lat 06 14 18 at 10 am

Sunday February the 25 1861
this day begins with fresh gales
squally rain steer W by N wind
Middle part moderate steer
W by N at 4 Capt off W
run down for Dominica
at 10 came to anchor Prince Rupert
very smooth

March the 4 Thursday 1861
at 6 took anchor at Dominica for
St. Eustacia fine breeze & E
steer this day E
