Goat No 43 55 & Leany in 49 am

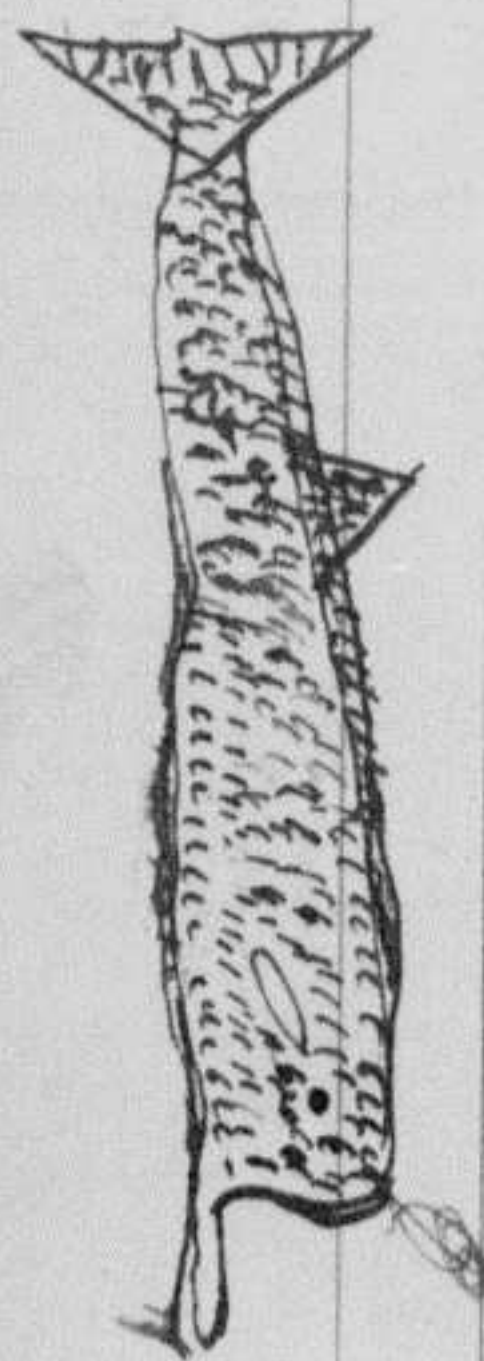
