Saturday May <sup>the</sup> 31 1862

this day begins with fresh gales N.W. heading N.W. at 4 were ship S at 9 were ship N.W.  
Closed reefed main topsail  
Middle part fresh gales N.E. W. heading N.W.  
Gutter part fresh breezes set four topsail took at 9 were ship South at 10 taken till four topsail  
Saw this day Lat 41 50 Long 34 00

Sunday May <sup>the</sup> June 1 1862

this day begins with fresh gales N.W. W. thick rain  
Middle part raining under short sail  
Gutter part Calm thick weather  
Saw one ship bound East  
Lat 42 00 Long

Monday June <sup>the</sup> 2 1862

this day begins with Calm rain  
Middle part lite breezes Calm  
Gutter part fine breezes from S.E. heading South saw 2 sails bound East  
Lat 42 04 N Long 33 39 W

Tuesday June <sup>the</sup> 3 1862

this day begins with fine breezes from S.E. heading N.E. by the wind  
Middle part fine breezes S.E. at 8 looked South under short sail  
Gutter part fresh breezes thick rain  
winds S.W. at 10 topped S.E.  
Lat 42 40 N Long 33 30 W

Wednesday June <sup>the</sup> 4 1862

this day begins with fresh breezes from West heading S.W.  
Middle part lite breezes N.W. W. heading S.W. short sail  
Gutter part fine weather all sail set heading South by the winds seen  
Lat 43 10 N Long 34 00 W

Thursday May <sup>the</sup> 5 1862

this day begins with lite breezes from S.W. all sail set started S.E.  
Middle part fresh breezes closed reefed four topsail at 10 were ship N.W.  
Gutter part fresh gales rapid at 7 closed reefed main topsail taken four topsail four sail seen  
Lat 44 00 N Long 34 00

Friday May <sup>the</sup> 6 1862

this day fresh gales S.W. thick rain heading N.W.  
Lat 44 40 Middle Gutter same set four sail  
Long 34 39 heading N.E. winds N.W. seen
