Sunday August ^{the} 10 1862

this day begins with fresh gales SW
both topsails fresh
middle part same moderate
Gutter fresh breezes SE set close reefed
topsails at 11 took in four topsail
heading SSE by the wind
Sailed 4200 N Long 3515 m

Monday August ^{the} 11 1862

this day begins with fresh gales SW
squally rain took in four topsail
lay under close reefed main & spencer
middle part same heading SSE
Gutter part SE set four topsail
heading SE by the wind
Sailed 4121 N Long 3350

Tuesday August ^{the} 12 1862

this day begins with fresh gales
Johnson SW squally took in four topsail
sick middle part same heavy rain
with laying under close reefed main
consumption Sailed Main & spencer
taken Gutter same moderate set sails
very reefed topsails set till 10
sick off spencer part for Deyal
to had had sick men heading
SSE wind SW by the wind
Sailed 4121 N Long 3256 m

Wednesday August ^{the} 13 1862

this day begins with fresh breeze
from SSW very weather
middle part same heading SSE
Gutter moderate winds SE
set hole topsails heading SE
Sailed 4057 N Long 3043 m

Thursday August ^{the} 14 1862

this day begins with fresh breeze
from SSW heading SE at 11 took in
middle part fresh breeze very
close reefed topsails thick rain
Gutter part fine breezes W W W
heading SE by the wind
set all sail sails
Sailed 4028 N Long 3106 at 4 m

Friday August ^{the} 15 1862

this day begins with fresh breeze
from W W fine weather steer SE
at 11 saw Curro bearing SSE dist 30 m
at sunset saw Teloras bearing south
steer down for Teloras middle part fine
Gutter fine weather steer down for
SS Cruise at 9 went on shore at 8 came
off to George Tanson on shore discharge
him sick with Consumption

Saturday August ^{the} 16 1862

this day fine weather got off 60 bushels
Potatoes 600 Onions 3 Pigeons
at 5 came off from shore spoke Banks
George Henry West Port since 1505
middle part fine weather
Gutter part the same steer off
West at 10 spoke Bank D R L. Banks
Clean smooth wind W W
Sailed 3902 N Long 3120 m
