 All hands employed stowing down  
 Oil Main satchels seeds

Saturday September <sup>the</sup> 6 1862  
 this day begins with fresh breezes  
 S. or S. heading East  
 Middle part fine weather & looked sea  
 Latter part like breezes S. or S. heading S. or S.  
 all hands employed stowing down Oil  
 Seeds Lat 37 15 N Long 36 20 W

Sunday September <sup>the</sup> 7 1862  
 this day begins with fresh breezes  
 S. or S. thick weather heading S. or S.  
 Middle part much the same  
 Latter same same Lat 36 32 N Long 37 52 W

Monday September <sup>the</sup> 8 1862  
 this day begins with fresh breezes  
 S. or S. rapid weather & took in mainsail  
 Middle part fresh gales & took in fore  
 Spunker Foretop sail & lost reefed main  
 heading S. or S. took in foresail  
 Latter part fresh gales squalls  
 rain seeds this sail reef  
 Lat 36 06 N Long 38 00 W

Tuesday September <sup>the</sup> 9 1862  
 this day begins with fresh gales  
 S. or S. heading S. or S. & lost reefed  
 Main topsail spencers  
 Middle part blowing heavy  
 at 8 took in main topsail heavy  
 squalls and rain  
 Latter part the same took in fore  
 topsail & lost at 11 wind hauled  
 S. or S. wore ship S. or S. seeds  
 Lat 36 20 N Long 38 30 W

Wednesday September <sup>the</sup> 10 1862  
 this day begins with heavy gales  
 from N. or N. at 3 S. or S. blowing  
 heavy rain took in four spencers  
 at 6 sun moderate at 12 set main  
 topsail four spencer heading S  
 Latter part S. or S. topsails main set  
 till heading S. or S. seeds  
 Lat 36 22 N Long 39 30 W

Thursday September <sup>the</sup> 11 1862  
 this day begins with fine breezes  
 S. or S. heading S. or S.  
 Middle part fine weather short sail  
 Latter part fresh breezes squalls  
 & lost reefed topsails took in till  
 Spunker wore ship west Lat 36 08 N Long 38 40 W
