Saturday July the 4 1863
 this day begins with breezes N
 steered N by W at 8 20 quite dark
 saw spouts suppose to be sperm
 whales heading SE wore ship steered
 till 12 night by the winds till late
 saw nothing maid sail steered East
 at 9 took west strong breezes rapid
 steered East at 39 20 N Geog in 32 50 W

Sunday July the 5 1863
 this day begins with fresh breezes
 from N by W rapid
 middle part wind N by W to West
 working Westward
 latter part wind N by W
 Lat 39 18 N Geog 29 08 W

Monday July the 6 1863
 this day begins with fresh breezes
 N by W heading N by W rapidly
 middle part moderate wind variable
 latter calm sent down fore & top sail
 to repair second & lower in side
 Lat 39 14 N Geog 30 38 W

Tuesday July the 7 1863
 this day begins with breezes calm
 middle part calm
 Lat 39 18 N Geog 30 03 W

Wednesday July the 8 1863
 this day begins with fine breezes S by W
 steered N by W middle part same
 latter part fresh breezes rapid at 10 me
 saw two leaved boat took on board
 found it to be Rose Bacon & was
 filled a barrel for skush soen
 Lat 39 26 N Geog in 32 50 W

Thursday July the 9 1863
 this day begins with fresh breezes N by W
 heading N by W
 middle part fine weather
 latter same at 8 took ship S by W all sail
 latter latitude 39 19 N Geog 33 06 W

Friday July the 10 1863
 this day begins with fine breezes N by W
 heading N by W
 middle part same all sail set
 gales thick heading SE second
 morning Lat 38 49 N Geog in 31 00 W
 heavy gales about 20 times

Saturday July the 11 1863
 this day begins with fresh breezes sea
 middle part same steered East
 latter fresh breezes S by W rain
 steered East soen
 Lat 39 10 N Geog in 29 10 W

Sunday July the 12 1863
 this day begins with fresh gales S by E
 heading East single reef top sail
 at 6 close reefed fore & top sail taken
 till 11 at 11 saw many close reefed
 main top sail taken fore & top sail
 fully under close reefed main top sail
 fore & main heading E thick rain
 latter part much the same
 Lat 39 05 N Geog 28 50 W
