This day begins with fine breezes S.W.
Middle part fine weather heading S
Lat 41 40 N Long 38 15 W

Thursday September ^{the} 10 1863

This day begins with shower rain
winds W
Middle part fine weather
Sends Lat 41 52 N Long 37 02

Friday September ^{the} 11 1863

This day begins with lite breezes calm
Middle part calm



Lat 41 52 N Long 36 40
Saw whale 4 points off weather bow
3 miles off boat beat for him
at 12 took him alongside cut him
in sends Lat 42 10 N Long 36 40

Saturday September ^{the} 12 1863

This day begins with lite breezes
from S.W. & from finished cut in
whale cut up blubber put in cask
Middle part fine weather
Lat 41 24 N Long 39 10 W



Sunday September ^{the} 13 1863

This day begins with fine breezes
S.W. heading W by S & were ship S
Middle part fine weather
Lat 41 24 N Long 39 10 W
Saw whale 11 30 boat beat for whale
at 12 we beat in chase sends
Whale going W 3 miles per hour
Lat 41 15 N Long 39 04

Monday September ^{the} 14 1863

This day begins with fine breezes &
boats in chase of whales at 4 o'clock
boat fastened whale got stone steamed
boat picked up once that boat went
after whale but neither faster nor nothing
else whale went off with tub line
at sunset set boats came on board whale
going W picked up boat almost all things
Middle part fine breezes heading
West all night short sail
Lat 41 08 N Long 38 57 W

Tuesday September ^{the} 15 1863

This day begins with fresh breezes
from S at 6 shorted sail for the night
Middle part fresh breezes night
at 11 took in fore top sail close reefed
Main heading S.W.
Lat 41 09 N Long 39 14 W

Wednesday September ^{the} 16 1863

This day begins with fresh gales
from S very rapid heading S.W.
at dark took in main top sail
thunder lightning rain
Middle part thick rain winds W
Lat 40 49 N Long 40 01

Thursday September ^{the} 17 1863

This day begins with lite breezes
Middle part same
Lat 40 46 N Long 39 09 W
