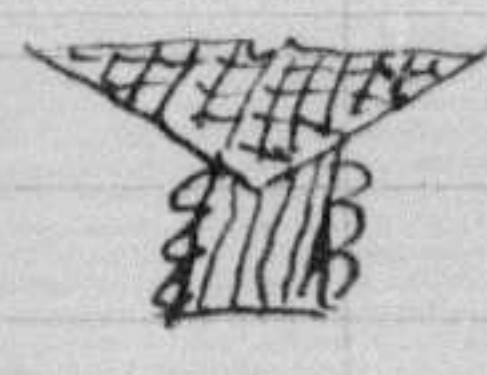
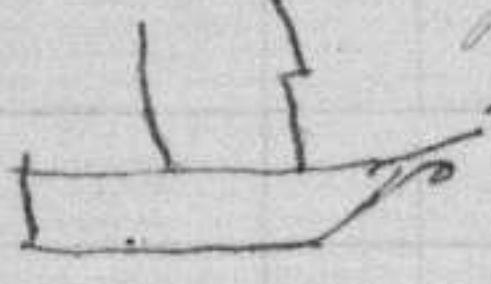
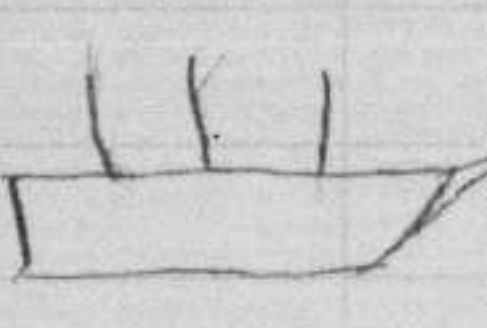


Sunday September <sup>the</sup> 27 1863

back heading West  
Gutter fine breezes S.W. led 8 W

Wednesday September <sup>the</sup> 30 1863  
this day begins with fine breezes  
S.W. at 4 30 saw 5 sperm whales  
4 points of weather bow 4 miles off  
at 4 30 saw 3 whales going  
quick W.W. West boat mile got  
on with little excursion at dark  
came on board Middle Gutter  
part fine breezes looking for whales  
Get 11 40 04 W Long 40 32 W



Wednesday October <sup>the</sup> 1 1863  
Thursday this day begins with fine breezes S.W.  
heading S.E. at 4 took 11 W.W.  
Middle part fine weather  
Gutter same at 6 saw 4 points  
off weather bow at 7 saw whale weather  
quarter at 8 boat boats in chase  
Saens boats in chase whales going S.E.  
Get 11 40 00 W Long 41 16 W

Thursday October <sup>the</sup> 2 1863  
Friday this day begins with fine breezes  
from S.W. S.W. boats in chase of  
whales West boat went long side of  
whale and not fasten at 2 came  
on board at 3 boat for whales  
Saens partent hold whale  
at 4 took whale to ship commence  
cutin cut til dark  
Middle part fresh gales squally  
lost reefed main top sail  
at 4 lite hooked on commence cutin  
at 5 finished cutin fresh gales and  
very rapid lost part case seen  
Get 11 40 10 W Long in 40 50 W

Saturday October <sup>the</sup> 3 1863  
this day begins with fresh gales S.W.  
Employed cutin up lunch packing  
Case at 5 wore ship W.W.  
Middle part heavy squalls wind rain  
til 12 midnite sun moon set  
at 4 stabled fine Boiling Bay  
Gutter part wind lite heavy  
Saens at 5 saw whale lost  
ship board two boats whales  
went to wind ward got men  
Get 11 40 28 W Long 41 54 W
