

Thursday August the 6 1868

This day begins with fine breezes from S.W. heading S by the wind all sail set Middle part fine weather at 1 in morning saw land Island of Tercera wone of western Islands took ship N.W. at 6 morning Island near S dist 25 miles latter lite breezes W to N.W. thick rain heading N.W. to N.W. at 12 we graciosa having dist 25 miles sails this day ship leaking bad when on Island took in crewing

Friday August 7 1868

This day begins with lite breezes from W heading N.W. to N.W. at 4 S.W. wind shifted N.W. Steer W Middle part calm latter part wind to Steer S.W. at 12 we graciosa near S dist 14 miles even

Saturday August the 8 1868

This day begins with lite breezes East steering S.W. for Pajal Middle part lite wind calm latter part fine breezes at 7 at 9 S.W. came to anchor at Pajal

Sunday August the 9 1868

This day fine weather shakedown boats crew on shore Frank Smith Henry Boel John Carney stepped on shore without permit over time

Monday the 10 August 1868

This day begins fine weather Middle part fresh breezes at 8 latter same Embarked knocking out cask to fill with water to heat ship to burn leak

Tuesday August the 11 1868

This day fresh breezes N.E. have the ship down by filling water on deck got the hot out water found it bad Carpenter came off sea what could be seen 4 S.W. Carpenters came on board to work found the put very bad John Carrol went on shore to sea the water you work

Wednesday Aug the 12 1868

This day begins with lite breezes N.E. Middle part same Carpenters to work Calken's Starboard side in west filling water on deck to heat hen cask burn on the yards filled with water John Carrol went on shore to sea the leak

Thursday August the 13 1868

This day begins with fresh breezes N.E. Calken could not work long side Middle part moderate latter part same at 6 A.M. Carpenters to work calking

Friday August the 14 1868

This day fine weather ship hauled on beam ends at sundown got sheathing on finished all could Freden Carpenters Carpens
