Saturday August ^{the} 29 1868
this day begins with lite breezes
from N.W. steering N.W.
at 4-30 saw *Spyrm. rubra* 6 miles
A head vessel board boats saw
no more of them at dark came on
board Middle part lite winds
Gutter part fine breezes N.W. & S.E.
heading N.W. So ends
Lea 2095 34.11' Long 31.15.44

Sunday August ^{the} 30 1868
this day begins with lite breezes
from N.W. heading N.W.
Middle part lite winds at 2 wind
Gutter N.W. round N.E.
Gutter fine weather heading E.S.E.
Saw *Silurus* having East by compass
Lea 2095 26.11' Long 31.20.43

Monday August ^{the} 31 1868
this day fine breezes N.E. steering
in for Flores saw 4 sails at sundown
West part *Silurus* hour N.W. 11.11.11
Middle part fine weather
Gutter part winds S.E. heading
E.S.E. saw one sail seen 1/2
Lea 2095 28.11' *Silurus* 20.11.11
West ends

Tuesday September ^{the} 1 1868
this day begins with lite winds calm
Middle part same heading S.E.
Gutter part lite winds N.W. sail set
Silurus having N.W. 11.11.11
So ends Lea 2095 13.11'

Wednesday September ^{the} 2 1868
this day begins with lite winds calm
at 4 spoke Bark *Silurus* Royal Clean
Middle part lite winds N.W.
Gutter part fine breezes N.W. steered S.E.
Royal in site steering down point
So ends

Thursday September ^{the} 3 1868
this day lite winds fine weather
steering in for Royal at 3 came
to anchor at Royal
Middle Gutter calm sent down
main yard being spring seaward

Friday September ^{the} 4 1868
fine weather winds from N.W.

Saturday September ^{the} 5 1868
this day fresh breezes N.E. rain
steering down provision seaward

Sunday September ^{the} 6 1868
this day fresh breezes N.W. 2 sails

Monday September ^{the} 7 1868
fresh gales rapid watch N.E.

Tuesday September ^{the} 8 1868
strong gales rapid watch on shore
