this day Begines with lite breezes
running for rack at 12.30 board two
boats for the rack haul Spanish
colars set on furey mast maine
at 4 till got down to her with truck
Spanish Capt on board rack
getting lite things from her the
Capt gave me all I could save
by getting 30 boxes sugar on board
the Spanish Brig and to have all
I could save went with 4 boats
put 29 boxes sugar on board
and took 86 boxes on board Addison
came on board at 12 night commen
ce stowing down the frozen cleats
at 4 went on board rack for
sugar Chanes board this day
Gout 14 1 24 N Gony in 4.20 m

Wednesday September the 30 1868

this day Begines with fresh breezes
from W. W. heading S. under Duple
in patch
ing sugar Chanes on board at 5.30
came on board to rugil to work
any longer set fire to rack
middle part fresh breezes rugil
employed in stowing down sugar
Gutter part fresh breezes rugil
heading S. watch employed
stowing down clearing decks
Spoke Brig
Gout 14 1 11 00 N Gony 4.30

Thursday October the 1 1868

this day Begines with fresh breezes
from W. S. W. heading S. under Duple
reefed main topsail Stanch
middle part same
Gutter part fresh breezes rugil
steer W. by N winds 2.50
Gout 14 1 13 N Gony in 4.10 m

Friday October the 2 1868

this day Begines with lite breezes
from N. E. steering W.
middle Gutter lite winds calm
Sends Gout 14 1 40 50 N Gony 4.50 m

Saturday October the 3 1868

this day Begines with lite winds S
middle part lite winds calm
Gutter part winds 1.40 heading W
Gout 14 1 41 10 N Gony in 4.00 m

Sunday October the 4 1868

this day Begines with lite breezes
from W. S. W. heading S.
middle part fresh breezes or rugil
at 11 tokin Secor topsails
Lille spanker 12 tokin
Foursal clost reefed main
topsail blowing hard 14.50
rain at 12 m more ship ran
to kin main topsail
Sends this day ship leaking
at the rate 2400 barrels
Stroker in 24 bars
