

Thursday July 16th 1868

Comes in with light airs and calm and hazy weather. Air from N.W. at 12 light air from W. Steering N.E. per compass 23 sail in sight today One looking green much like the look of Morris. Saw white birds One Humphreys for which we lowered and chased with two boats. White boat going on and drifting and not fastening. Saw two storks and tallow birds water black. Water still very green about 3' f. for judging our selves to be in Lat 49.50 Long 22.25 found a little water that was water blue, at 6 P.M. steering N.E. W. Co. per compass 24. joints perfectly variation Lat at Merid 49.26 Long by Chron 22.30

Friday July 17th

Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. and overcast with fog and rain. Ship cruising on different tracks rather working to the N. Below a patch of blue water in the morning in Lat 49.30 Long 22.40 saw Tadastula quite plenty in it. Saw several finbacks several Gulls and one steamer. Green water extending to Lat 49.20 in Long of 22.40 working to the N. in and out of green water behind the line, running N.E. Lat at Merid 49.31 Long 22.45

Saturday July 18th 1868

Begins with moderate breezes from N.W. and overcast with fog and rain. Saw two sails called one the Lion & Harris - all C.D.M. Mett shot to the land Co. saw one finback water green without anything in it. Saw but one or two birds. Looks dull and gloomy except on the S.M. Steered awhile to the N. then came ship at 2 and kept by the wind until night from 4 till night saw black tracks in the water between 11 and 12 ran through a patch of blue water. No tallow birds at sunset one sail in sight bearing N. call it a whaler. Lat at Merid 49.03 Long by Chron 21.55

Sunday July 19th

First part of weather with light air from the N. One sail in sight standing to the N.W. We are cruising to the N. at 1 P.M. spoke the Park Soldier Cornell 125 Bbls this season one whale had seen whales but since reports several ships here on the ground none had seen whales but him. Landed with the C.D. Lat at Merid 48.49 Long by Chron 22.00
