

Sunday Aug. 16th 1868
 Comes in with strong breezes from E and
 cloudy weather - wind hauling to the South gradually
 at 12 wind south and blowing
 quite fresh - nothing in sight all day
 first part ship by the wind heading to the
 South under easy sail - In the afternoon
 standing to the South-east - at sunset
 shortened sail Lat at merid 41 28
 Long by Chrono, 48.44

Monday Aug. 17th
 All this day strong breezes from the S. S.
 W. and cloudy weather with some squalls of
 rain. Ship by the wind heading to the W.
 N. W. under easy sail - saw several fin
 backs - and one shoal of Grampuses - One or two of
 porpoises - find a strong S. E. set.
 Lat 40.56
 Long 48 00

Tuesday Aug. 18th
 Comes in with strong breezes from the S.
 Ship by the wind heading N. W. by W.
 in the forenoon moderates a little. At
 11 had all sail on ship steering N. W.
 - saw Grampuses
 Lat. 40.29 Long 48.07

Wednesday Aug. 19th 1868
 Comes in with moderate breezes from the S
 and squally weather. Ship by the wind head-
 ing N. W. by W. with all sail out - all fore-
 part of the day nothing in sight - not even
 a bird in the afternoon saw two or three
 birds - a shoal of porpoises and one sail
 steering off to the north and east. The ground
 is very dry here and the prospect dull - are none
 on the ground where we saw plenty whales last
 season but there is nothing here now.
 Lat. at merid 40 49
 Long by Chrono 49 06

Thursday Aug. 20th
 Begins with moderate breezes from the S. and
 fine weather. Ship by the wind to the W.
 with all sail out. One or two sail in
 sight steering to the E. - but no whales
 Blackfish porpoises or birds Lat 41 29
 Long 50 06

Friday Aug. 21st
 Begins with fresh breezes from the South and
 fine weather - first part by the wind to the
 N. W. by W. but part of the day - One sail
 in sight steering to the E. - saw considerable
 number birds flying - nothing more in sight
 Lat 41.19 Long 51.26
