

Copy of Agreement with Chas. W. Dalry

It is hereby agreed between the undersigned
Capt. Gilbert B. Borden and Chas. W. Dalry, ^{son}
the second named parties, having the
control of the vessel called the "Season" under
the Portuguese flag (both name and nation-
ality to be changed if desirable) do hereby agree
to give the command of said vessel to the
said Borden and the said Borden agrees to
take the command upon the following terms:
- The said Borden to be allowed to ship his
principal officers & have her fitted for the
whale fishing in accordance with his views of
what may be requisite for the purpose
(The said vessel is to be altered to a Bark
rig) and he is to be allowed to take an
interest of from $\frac{1}{16}$ One sixteenth to $\frac{1}{4}$ One
quarter, estimating the actual value of the
vessel at the present time at nine thousand
Dollars Gold, said Borden is further
to be allowed a lay of one tenth of the
oil taken and One Dollar per barrel Boun-
ty & the privilege of taking his wife
The voyage is to commence in the
spring of 1879 and to continue eighteen
months, a little more or a little less as
may be determined for the general interest
In case of the loss of said vessel the agreement
terminates
