

Remarks on Board the Bark Ocean Steed in
Russell Master

wednesday July the 12th 13 1870
This day commenced with very ~~heating~~ heavy
rain & light winds from the west saw one sail
heading to the N.W. so ended this day Sat 38° N
Long 48° 10' W

Thursday July the 13th 14
First part commenced with very heavy
rain squally but light winds the ship steering
E by S at sunset clew down the upper top sails
& luffed to taa the wind heading N.W. middle
& latter part the same at 4 am wore ship to
the South at 6 am kept off N.E. at 8 am saw
Black fish sawed one bait & got one &
kept off N.E. again Sat 40° 48' N
Long 49° 03' W

Friday July the 14th 15
This day commenced with light winds from
the N.W. saw more Black fish still steering
N.E. At 2 P.M. luffed to taa the the wind
the ship heading N.W. middle part fresh
breeze & thick foggy at 8 am wore ship to
the South saw one sun fish so ended this day
Sat 40° 25' N
Long 47° 12' W

Saturday July the 16th
This day commenced with fresh breeze at
one pm wore ship to the N.W. under had top
sail, still fresh winds at sunset took in
the upper top sail, & main sail & mizen top
sail middle & latter part more moderate
the wind from W. saw porpoise so ended
this day

Sat 40° 40' N
Long 47° 35' W

the North Atlantic Ocean Sailing for sperm whale,

Sunday July the 17th 1870
This day commenced with moderate gale, from
W.S.W. the ship heading N.W. saw porpoise
at sunset the weather a bit the same middle
part rain & very thick cloudy latter part
pleasant weather saw nothing so ended this day
Sat 40° 29' N
no Long

Monday July the 18th
First part of this day commenced with very
light air & calm at one pm saw Black fish still
clm at sunset took in the light sails the
weather still the same middle & latter part
rain saw one sail the ship steering N.E.
so ended this day Sat 40° 36' N
Long 46° 40' W

Tuesday July the 19th
all this 24 hours light wind & rain & thick
cloudy saw one sail & porpoise Brake out
water so ended this day Sat 40° 35' N
Long 46° 54' W

wednesday July the 20th
This day commenced with very light winds
& rain saw one sail at sunset took in the
upper top sails middle part fresh breeze &
clear at day light made sail saw nothing
so ended this day

Thursday July the 21st
all this 24 hours fine pleasant weather
saw nothing so ended this day
