

Remains on Board the Bark Ocean Steered in
Elisha & Russell Master

Monday August the 1st 1870
all this 24 hours fine pleasant weather
saw nothing so ended this day

Tuesday August the 2nd
This day commenced with calm at sunset
took in the light sails Middle & latter part
the same saw nothing so ended this day

Wednesday August the 3rd
all this 24 hours calm one sail in sight
still employed on ship's duty so ended this
day

Thursday August the 4th
First part of this day calm at sunset
this sail still in sight Middle part
still calm at day light sail in sight
the wind from W the ship heading N.
by W so ended this day

Friday August the 5th
This day commenced with light breeze
from W the ship still heading N by W
2 sails in sight at sunset took in the light
sails Middle part cloudy at day light
rain squally saw 2 more sails beyond
to the East so ended this day

Saturday August the 6th
This day commenced with very fine winds
from S W the ship heading N by W one sail in sight
Middle & latter part fresh wind & rain squally
saw 2 sails so ended this day
Lat 38° 15' N
Long 50°

the North Atlantic Ocean cruising for sperm
Whales

Sunday August the 7th 1870
First part of this day fresh wind still from
S W the ship heading N W at 6 P.M. wore ship
to the South still fresh wind at 8 P.M. wore ship
to the N W again Middle part took in the upper
top sail still fresh wind at day light moderate
gale latter part more moderate & very heavy
rain saw nothing so ended this day no obs

Monday August the 8th
First part of this day commenced with rain
& moderate winds from N E the ship heading
N W at 3 P.M. ^{saw} sail to the west steering to
the East at sunset the weather a but the same
Middle part moderate at day light set all
sail & steering N N W the winds from the East
saw nothing so ended this day no obs

Tuesday August the 9th
First part of this day very pleasant weather
the ship still steering N N W with all sail
out at sunset took in the light sail the
wind very light Middle part a but the
same at day light set all sail one sail in
sight so ended the day Lat 40° 12' N
Long 46° 25' W

Wednesday August the 10th
First part of this day calm still one sail
in sight at sunset took in the flying jib &
all the stay sail still calm the ship heading
N W Middle part still calm at day light
set all sail latter part a but the same
so ended this day no obs
