First part of this day light wind & very
 smoke saw one sail bound to the S.W. we
 still in employed on ship duty at sunset
 took in sail & luff to the wind heading
 S.E. at day light set all sail & steering South
 saw nothing so ended this day Lat 31° 35' S
 Long 44° 12' W

Thursday January the 11th

First part of this day very light breeze &
 foggy the ship still heading South Middle part
 light wind & very thick foggy at day light
 still thick foggy latter part fine pleasant
 weather saw Pariaes so ended this day
 Lat 32° 09' S
 Long 44° 14' W

Friday January the 12th

First part fine pleasant weather the
 ship steering South at sunset took in the top
 sails & steering S.W. by W Middle part thick
 foggy at day light the same latter part fine
 weather saw nothing so ended the day
 Lat 32° 43' S
 Long 45° 05' W

Saturday January the 13th

First part of this day fine light weather
 the ship steered S.W. with all sail out
 Middle & latter part fresh breeze saw 3 sail
 so ended this day Lat 33° 05' S
 Long 46° 50' W

Sunday January the 14th

This day commenced with fresh breeze 3 sail, in
 sight the ship still steering S.W. by W Middle
 latter part still fresh wind saw nothing
 at 11 30 A.M. ware ship to the S.E. so ended
 this day Lat 33° 43' S
 Long 48° 35' W
