First part of this day calm still one sail in sight at sunset took in the light sail still calm middle & latter part light wind & rain one sail in sight so ended, this day

First part of this day light wind & rain at 4 P.M. spoke the Barque Seaconia the capt went on board at 4 P.M. the capt came on board & took in sail for the night middle & latter part light wind & thick still employed on ship duty, saw nothing so ended, this day Sat 31st 19 S
Long 45th 58 m.

Thursday Feb. the 29th

This day commenced with light wind & very cloudy at sunset took in the light sail & saw 3 sperm whales still cruising for sperm whales middle & latter part calm breeze at day light saw sperm whales going to wind ward lowered 3 boats but no success so ended, this day Sat 31st 30 S
Long 46th 05 m.

Friday March the 1st 1872

This day commenced with calm one sail in sight at sunset took in the light sail & main sail 2 sails in sight the ship headed to South middle & latter part still calm one sail in sight on vent spar for repair so ended, this day
no ab.

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Saturday March the 2nd

First part of this day calm & rain still one sail in sight at sunset the weather a but the same 2 sails in sight took in the light sail middle part light breeze at day light set all sail one sail in sight still cruising so ended, this day Sat 31st 55 S
Long 45th 27 m.

Sunday March the 3rd

First part of this day fine pleasant weather still one sail in sight at sunset took in sail for night middle part calm at day light heavy rain one sail in sight latter part fine pleasant weather 2 sails in sight so ended, this day Sat 31st 23 S
Long 45th 25 m.

Monday March the 4th the

First part of this day light wind still one sail in sight at sunset calm all up for sail & main sail middle part light breeze at day light saw sperm whales going to wind ward lowered 3 boats but no success so ended, this day Sat 31st 16 S
Long 45th 17 m.

Tuesday March the 5th

First part of this day fine breeze & haze saw nothing at sunset took in sail for the night middle & latter part very light weather & very haze saw nothing so ended, this day Sat 31st 00 S
Long 45th 52 m.
