Friday March the 22nd 1872
 First part of this day fresh wind, & very cloudy the wind from N^W & the ship under short sail at sunset more moderate still very cloudy Middle & latter part fresh wind & squally 3 sail, in sight so ended, this day

Sat 31st 23 S

Saturday March the 23rd Long 45th 23 m
 First part of this day fresh wind & squally still 3 sail, in sight at sunset the weather a but the same Middle & latter part light winds 2 sail, in sight so ended, this day

Sat 31st 21 S

Long 45th 18 m

Sunday March the 24th
 First part of this day very light weather at sunset 2 sails the Barque Savonia again Middle part calm latter part light breeze still 2 sail, in sight so ended, this day

Sat 31st 11 S

Long 45th 05 m

Monday March the 25th
 First part of this day light breeze & light rain squally the Savonia still in sight at sunset took in the light sail Middle & latter part fresh breeze & rain the wind from S^W kept steering N^W & several sail, in sight so ended, this day

Sat 30th 51 S
 Long 44th 56 m

Tuesday March the 26th 1872
 First part of this day breeze fresh breeze & rain squally still several sail, in sight the ship still steering N^W & Baund off out this Middle & latter part fine pleasant breeze saw nothing so ended, this day

Sat 28th 54 S

Long 42nd 53 m

Wednesday March the 27th
 First part of this day light wind, still from S^W at sunset took in sail still steering N^W & Middle part light winds from South at day light set all sail still steering N^W & saw 2 sail, so ended, this day

Sat 27th 32 S

Long 41st 42

Thursday March the 28th
 First part of this day light pleasant weather at sunset the weather still very fine Middle & latter part very light weather saw nothing still a m^{pl} day in ship duty so ended, this day

Sat 26th 44 S

Long 40th 43 m

Friday March the 29th
 This day commenced with very light weather still steering N^W & Middle & latter part very light wind, saw nothing so ended, this day

Sat 26th 07 S
