

Remarks on Board the Barque Ocean Steamer in the North Atlantic Ocean Bound to
 Elsha & Russell Master

Tuesday April the 30th 1872
 First part fine pleasant weather the ship steering N.W. with all sail out still one sail in sight steering the same middle & latter part very fine wind nothing in sight so ended, this day.

 Long 42^h 56^m

Wednesday May the 1st
 First part fine pleasant wind from N.E. & fine weather the ship steering N.W. with all sail out middle & latter part fine pleasant weather saw nothing still employed on ship duty so ended, this day.

Sat 8^h 58^m
 Long 44^h 31^m

Thursday May the 2nd
 This day commenced with very fine breeze the ship steering N.W. by N. with all sail set middle & latter part still fine winds nothing in sight so ended, this day.

Sat 10^h 47^m
 Long 46^h 22^m

Friday May the 3rd
 First part of this day fine pleasant weather the ship still steering N.W. by N. with all sail out still employed on ship duty middle part light wind at day light saw a school of sperm whales going to windward, saw 3 boats at 11 A.M. came on board without success kept off again N.W. by N. so ended, this day.

Sat 12^h 21^m
 Long 47^h 45^m

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Saturday May the 4th 1872
 First part of this day whales in sight at one 30 P.M. saw 3 boats, again at 4 P.M. came on board without success kept off again & steering N.W. by N. middle & latter part fine breeze saw nothing still employed on ship duty so ended, this day.

 Long 48^h 55^m

Sunday May the 5th
 This day commenced with very fine weather the ship still steering N.W. by N. all day 24 hours fine pleasant weather saw one sail bound to the West so ended, this day.

Monday May the 6th
 First part of this day fine pleasant weather the ship still steering N.W. by N. middle & latter part very fine weather saw nothing so ended, this day.

Sat 17^h 33^m

 First part fine pleasant weather the ship still N.W. by N. with all sail out middle & latter part very fine weather saw 2 sails bound to the West so ended, this day.
