Wednesday May the 8th 1872
This day commenced with fine pleasant weather still one sail in sight we still steering N^W by N^W with all sail set middle part light winds at day sight one sail in sight so ended, this day

Thursday May the 9th
First part of this day fine pleasant weather the sail still in sight call the sea etia middle & latter part very fine weather saw one sail bound to the S^W so ended, this day

Sat 22° 02' N
Long 57° 11' W

Friday May the 10th
First part fine breeze from the East the ship still steering N^W by N^W still with all sail out middle & latter part fresh breeze from East saw nothing so ended, this day

Sat 23° 50' N
Long 58° 55' W

Saturday May the 11th
First part fine pleasant breeze, the ship still steering N^W by N^W still with all sail out middle & latter part fine weather saw one sail bound to the S^W so ended, this day

Sat 25° 59' N

Long 60° 59' W

in the North Atlantic Ocean still bound in to Bermuda

Sunday May the 12th 1872
This day commenced with very fine weather the ship still steering N^W by N^W with all sail out middle & latter part light winds still from E N^E & saw nothing so ended, this day

Sat 27° 40' N

Long 62° 47' W

Monday May the 13th
This day commenced with light winds & very fine weather still steering N^W by N^W with all sail out middle & latter part fine light breeze saw 2 sail, bound to the East so ended, this day

Sat 29° 05' N

Long 63° 42' W

Tuesday May the 14th
First part fine pleasant weather the ship steering N^W by N^W the wind from South middle & latter part light breeze saw 2 sail, bound to the East still employed on ship duty so ended, the day

Sat 29° 51' N

Long 64° 18' W

Wednesday May the 15th
This day commenced with very light airs the ship steering N^W by N^W saw one sail bound to the East middle & latter part light airs & calm saw nothing so ended, the day

Sat 30° 21' N
