Thursday Sept 21st 1854

Fresh breeze from the South and squally
 steering East with all sail out at 2 p.m. took
 in top gable sail Latter much the same
 S. Inds

Friday 22nd

First part fresh breeze and squally steering
 E. S. South Latter part much the same S. Inds
 Lat.

Saturday 23rd

First part strong wind from the S.W. and
 squally Mid & Latter squally with rain & Inds
 S. Inds

Sunday 24th

First part fresh breeze and squally ship under
 double reef at 4 p.m. took in the top sail and
 fore sail and wore ship to the Westward blowing
 heavy Latter part more moderate left off steering
 E. S. E. and made sail S. Inds

First part Light breeze from the Westward
 and fine weather E. S. E. & S. Inds

Tuesday 26th

First part strong breeze from the Westward and
 cloudy Latter strong double reefed the top sails

First part breeze from the N.W. and squally

 out S. Inds

Thursday Sept 28th 1854

First part Moderate breeze from the N.E.
 steering S. S. E. at 2 p.m. saw the Island of Flores
 steering East 30 miles off Mid & Latter fresh breeze
 steering E. S. E. at 10 p.m. saw Pagat Baring E. S. E.
 Lat 40 miles S. Inds

Friday 29th

First part Moderate breeze from the North and
 fine weather at 5 p.m. got down coast to the land
 took in sail for the night Laid off till morning
 round in at 8 went on shore and carried two
 sick men to discharge several ships here
 S. Inds

Saturday 30th

First part fresh breeze from the North at 2 p.m.
 took our recruits on board 30 bushels Potatoes 15 Do
 onions and 10 pumpkins at 5 left off steering South
 Mid & Latter Moderate breeze from the North and
 ship in sight

Lat 35° 33'

Sunday Oct 1st 1854

First part Light breeze from the Westward
 and fine weather Mid & Latter much the same

Lat 33° 47'

Monday 2nd

First part Light breeze from the Westward
 and fine weather steering S. S. E. Lat 30° 46'

Long 26° 00'

Tuesday Oct 3rd

First part Light wind from the South and
 fine weather steering S. S. E. Mid & Latter light wind
 heading N. E. W. by the wind S. Inds
