Wednesday Oct 7th

Came with light breeze from from N.W. and squally heading S.W. by S. Latter pleasant S.W. 10 16

Thursday 8th

Came with light breeze and pleasant heading W. S. W. several sail in site. Latter fine weather S.W. Lat 27° 33 Long 26° 20

Friday 9th

Came with light air and calm employed in stringing up the fore rigging. Latter light trades and fine weather S.W. Lat 25° 48

Saturday 10th

Came with light trades and fine weather. Starting S.W. with all sail out of S.W. Lat 23° 11

Sunday 11th

Came with light trades and fine weather. Starting South with all sail out two sail in site S.W. Lat 20° 29 Long 24° 40

Monday 12th

Came with Light S.W. trades and fine weather. Starting South Mid S. Latter fine weather. Starting S.W. by S. Lat 17° 46

Tuesday 13th

Came with fresh S.W. trades. Starting S.W. by S. there sail in site at 2 p.m. made the Island of St. Antonio 40 miles off left off and run to the leeward of it. Mid moderate. Latter fresh trades. Starting South S.W. Lat 15° 26 Long 25° 16

Wed 11th Oct 1834

Came with fresh trades and fine weather. Starting South with all sail out two sail in site. Latter light trades S.W. Lat 12° 50 Long 24° 44

Thursday 12th

First part light trades and fine weather. Starting South saw and heard from Blackfish mid out such as several sail in site S.W. Lat 10° 50 Long 24° 20

Friday 13th

First part light S.W. trades and fine weather. Chast Blackfish mid fine. Starting S.W. by S. Latter squally ship on different tack S.W. Lat 9° 00 Long 25° 38

Saturday 14th

First Light airs from the South heading S.W. by S. Mid S. Latter part squally with but little wind S.W. Lat 8° 34 Long 23° 09

Sunday 15th

First part calm Mid S. Latter part Light and squally heading on different tack S.W. Lat 8° 11 N Long 22° 38

Monday 16th

First part Light airs from the northward and fine weather several sail in site. Mid S. Latter Light airs from the North. Starting South S.W. Lat 7° 33
