

Remarks On Board Ship *Cemulge*

Saturday Nov 11 1834

First light airs from the N.W. and fine weather at 3 P.M. sent up the fore top sail yard and bent the sail Mid & Latter fresh breeze from the Westward and rugged at 8 A.M. took the Bark *Mirrod* of Sagharboe 11 1/2 Months out 30th June 1834 Lat 36° 33'

Sunday 12th

First part fresh breeze from the Westward heading to the North at 3 P.M. saw and chased a right whale Mid & Latter strong wind and squally at 8 A.M. saw sperm whales going quick to windward ship on different tracks under double reefs & on Lat 35° 57' Long 9° 40'


Monday 13th

First part strong breeze and rugged ship on different tracks Mid & Latter part strong wind from the Westward ship on different tracks saw a bark boiling & on Lat 35° 00' Long 9° 27'

Tuesday 14th

First part strong wind from the Westward Mid fresh from the S.W. and rugged ship on different tracks & on Lat 35° 36' Long 9° 04'

Wednesday 15th

First part strong breeze from the S.W. and rugged at 2 A.M. and chased whales at 3 chased again well out of view Mid & Latter part more moderate at 7 A.M. saw and lowered for whales got one at 10 took him to the ship and commenced cutting & on 

of *Susbury* *Martha's Vineyard*

Thursday Nov 16 1834

First strong wind from the S.W. and rugged at 2 P.M. got through cutting Mid & Latter part strong gale commenced boiling & on bark in site Lat 35° 00'

Friday 17th

First part fresh gale from the S.W. and rugged Mid & Latter more moderate made sail & on Lat 36° 09'

Saturday 18th

First part light breeze from the S.W. Mid & Latter part calm got through boiling one bark in site & on Lat 35° 57' Long 9° 07'

Sunday 19th

First part light airs from the Westward and fine weather heading to the S.W. Mid & Latter part light airs from the North and fine weather steering to South the bark *Mirrod* in site & on Lat 36° 32' Long 9° 00'

Monday 20th

First part light breeze from the North and fine weather steering to the Eastward Mid & Latter part light and thick rainy & on Lat 35° 11'

Tuesday 21st

First part light breeze from the Westward and thick fog laid down Mid & Latter gentle breeze and fine weather steering to the N.E. & on Lat 35° 51' Long 6° 59'
