Thursday Dec 28th 1834

First part Light breeze from the E.N.E. and fine weather Latter strong from N.E. Staring S.E. Ends
Lat 38.46 Long 30.37

Friday 29th

First part fresh breeze from S.E. and fine weather Staring S.E. Mid is Latter strong wind from S.W. and ruffled saw a Ship Staring to Eastward & Ends
Lat 40.58 Long 34.35

Saturday 30th

First part fresh breeze from the S.W. Staring S.E. Mid and Latter moderate breeze from the S.W. and fine weather saw finbacks & Ends this day
Lat 41.45 Long 37.20

Sunday 31st

First part Light breeze from the S.W. and fine weather Staring S.E. by S. Mid Light airs and thick fog Latter the same. Ends No Ob

Monday January 1st 1835

First part Light airs from N.W. and thick fog Staring S.E. by S. Latter fresh breeze and clear
Lat 44.00
Long 42.20 E

Tuesday 2nd

First part strong breeze Staring S.E. at dark took in all but abast reefed main-top sail and fore-topmast staysail Mid is Latter fresh gale from the S.W. thick rain at 7 AM. Left to heading East
Lat 46.85

Wednesday 3rd

First part fresh gale from the S.W. heading East thick fog Mid is Latter part fresh gale from S.W. left off Staring S.E. under double reefs & Ends saw Blackfish
Lat 45.44 Long 46.00

Thursday Jan 4 1835

First part fresh gale from S.W. Staring S.E. at 4 P.M. took in sail blowing heavy abast reefed the main-top sail Mid is Latter more moderate Made sail heading S.E. by S. and ship with all sail out
Lat 45.11 Long 49.10 E

Friday 5th

First part gentle breeze from the South and fine weather heading S.E. with all sail out
Mid is Latter Light airs Ends Lat 44.45
Long 50.05

Saturday 6th

First part calm Mid Latter part Light breeze from the S.E. and fine weather heading to the S.E. 3 or 4 miles thick fog No Ob

Sunday 7th

First part Light breeze from S.E. and some thick Staring S.E. but the fore-topmast & middling sail Mid is Latter gentle breeze and some thick Ends
Lat about 45.50 Long 55.30 E

Monday 8th

First part gentle breeze from N.E. and clear Staring S.E. Mid is Latter part moderate & Ends
Lat 46.55 Long 57.17

Tuesday 9th

First part fresh breeze from the S.W. heading S.E. by S. Barometer thirty and one tenth Mid is Latter moderate & Ends
Lat 47.30 Long 61.40 E

Wednesday 10th

First part Light airs from Eastward heading to the South Mid is Latter much the same thick Ends No Ob
