

Remark On Board Ship Ocmulgee

Thursday Jan 11th 1835

First part light breeze from the N.E. and foggy. Starting E. mid & latter moderate and fine weather saw and landed from Blackfish got fore got one boat capsized lost one shot of live birds Lat 48.04 Long 63.00

Friday 12th

First part gentle breeze from the N.W. starting N.E. with all sail out mid & latter part fresh breeze and some thick at 11 saw the rock coulda Blighs Cap of the Is of Devolution Is. Lat 48.15 Long 69.00

Saturday 13th

First part fresh breeze from West and some thick starting E.S. at 2 p.m. spoke the ship Congress of New Bedford. Helly. Cruising mid & latter part strong breeze from West starting E.S. at 10:30 a.m. saw and landed for two right whales going quick to the Westward. Snd Lat 47.40 Long 73.25

Sund 14th

First part fresh breeze from West N.W. starting E.S. Boiled and the Blackfish 7 m. mid & latter strong gale from N.W. Snd Lat 47.14 Long 78.50

Monday 15th

First part strong gale from N.W. and clear starting E.S. mid & latter part more moderate wind from N.E. Snd Lat 46.52 Long 83.37

Tuesday 16th

First part light breeze from West starting E.S. mid & latter light breeze from N.W. and fine weather saw finbacks Snd Lat 46.41 Long 86.68

Wednesday Jan 17th 1835

First part light breeze from the N.W. and fine weather starting E.S. mid & latter strong breeze and some thick Snd Lat 46.31 Long 92.14

Thursday 18th

First part strong breeze from N.W. and some thick starting E.S. mid & latter fresh gale and some thick Snd Lat 45.35 Long 99.25

Friday 19th

First part fresh gale from West and some squally took in main top gilliant sail mid & latter fresh at 11 a.m. dark night the top sails Snd Lat 45.13

Saturday 20th

First part strong gale from West and squally starting E.S. under double reef mid & latter more moderate shook out the reefs set the main top gilliant sail thick foggy Snd No CB

Sunday 21st

First part fresh breeze from W.N.W. and thick starting E.S. mid & latter part much the same Snd Lat 44.10 Long 111.21

Monday 22nd

First part strong wind from N.W. and some shook starting E.S. mid & latter fresh breeze and thick foggy Snd No CB
