First part fresh breeze from the W.S.W. and thick steering E & S latter part fresh wind from N.W. and cloudy P.M. Lat 44.22 Long 120.15 E

Wednesday 24<sup>d</sup>

First Strong Breeze from N.W. and cloudy steering East Mid. Strong from the North latter Strong Breeze from the West and fine weather Lat 44.19 Long 125.14 E

Thursday 25<sup>d</sup>

First part Strong Breeze from the West and fine weather steering East Mid. & latter Light air from the S.E. P.M. Lat 44.12 Long 125.58

Friday 26<sup>d</sup>

First part Light air from the Eastward heading to the South Mid. & latter Light Breeze from the S.W. and fine weather steering East Lat 44.02 Long 130.14

Saturday 27<sup>d</sup>

First part Light air from the N.W. and fine weather steering East Mid. & latter Light air from the North and fine saw a whale going quick to the Westward could it a right whale to end Lat 44.08 Long 132.16 E

Sunday 28<sup>d</sup>

First part Light air from the North and fine weather steering East with all sail out Mid. & latter Strong Breeze from N.W. and some thick P.M. Lat 44.10 Long 135.14

Monday January 29<sup>d</sup> 1855

First part Strong Breeze from the North and thick steering East Mid. & latter Strong Breeze from the N.W. and cloudy steering E & S P.M. Lat 44.32 Long 139.51 E

Tuesday 30<sup>d</sup>

First part Strong Breeze from West steering E & S & Mid. & latter Strong Breeze from the West steering E & S Lat 44.08 Long 144.14 E

Wednesday 31<sup>d</sup>

First part Strong Breeze from the N.W. and fine clear weather steering E & S & Mid. & latter Strong Breeze and fine weather at 5 P.M. saw the West. Cape of St. Lawrence Land bearing N West 10 miles Lat 44.02 Past Casman's head steering up Horn Bay P.M.

Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> Feb. came to anchor in Holst Bay

Friday 2<sup>d</sup> 1855

Saturday latter part Light Breeze from the North and fine weather at 6 took the anchor and run out at 10 out West the Head Land the Sheffield in company P.M.

Saturday 11<sup>d</sup>

Sunday First part fresh Breeze from N.W. heading East double reefed the top sails Mid. & latter Moderate P.M. Lat 45.15 Long 149.53

Sunday 15<sup>d</sup>

Monday First part Light air from the N.W. and some thick Mid. and latter part Moderate steering N.E. the Sheffield in site
