Tuesday March 31st 1855

First part Strong Breeze from the N.W. and some squally during N.W. & M. Mid & Latter Strong Breeze and fine weather. Lat 8.41 Long 161.17

Wednesday 28th

First part Strong Breeze from the N.W. & fine weather Mid & Latter part fresh Breeze during N.W. Lat 11.38 N Long 161.15.8

Thursday 29th

First part Gentle Breeze from the N. and fine weather during N.W. Mid & Latter much the same Lat 13.05 Long 161.20

Friday 30th

First part Gentle Breeze from N. and fine weather during N.W. saw a sail during A.M. returned Mid & Latter much the same Lat 15.30 N Long 164.35.16

Saturday 31st

First part gentle Breeze from N. and fine weather during N.W. Mid Light air Latter calm Light air and fine weather Lat 17.44 Long 163.58

Sunday April 1st 1855

First part Light air from the Eastward during N.W. saw and chased Blackfish without success Mid Light air Latter calm with fine clear weather Lat 18.27 Long 163.50

Monday April 2nd 1855

First part Light air from the N.W. heading N.W. Mid & Latter Strong Breeze from the N.W. heading N.W. & S.W. Lat 19.47 N Long 152.21 E

Tuesday 3rd

First part Strong Breeze from the N.W. & heading N.W. set the top galleon sails Mid & Latter fresh Breeze during N.W. & S.W. rugged S.W. Lat 21.50 Long 150.41

Wednesday 4th

First part Gentle Breeze from the S.W. and fine weather during N.W. with all sail out Mid & Latter Light Breeze from the South Lat 24.17 Long 150.00

Thursday 5th

First part fresh Breeze from the South and varying during N.W. Mid & Latter gentle Breeze from N.W. and fine weather heading N.W. Put about 70 Bushels of Potatoes down below Lat 26.14 Long 150.26

Friday 6th

First part Gentle Breeze from the N.W. and fine weather heading N.W. Mid & Latter calm Lat 26.30 Long 150.10

Saturday 7th

First part Light Breeze from the S.W. and fine weather during N.W. saw four backs Mid & Latter part gentle from the S.W. and fine weather Lat 28.37 Long 150.06
