

Remarks On Board Ship Cumulge

Thursday May 24 1835

First part fresh breeze from South and
the ship moved the ice about 30 ships in site
Latter part breeze saw two whole chest without suchness
saw one Barge got a whole 2 ends

Friday 25th

First part strong breeze from the South and the
ship in with the ice 13 ships in site Mid is latter
part light airs and thick in with the ice and
saw Jonas Stand being 12 miles off

Saturday 26th

First part light airs and some thick the ice in
site at 8 A.M. spoke the ship Harvest of New Bedford
1 whole this season and Choufion Edgartown 3 whole
Mid is latter thick fog 2 ends

Sunday 27th

First part light airs and thick at 4 p.m.
Lighter and saw whole Lander and got one
at 9 A.M. took him to the ship and took in sail
at 3 P.M. hoist in broke one of the bars to the
windlass bore with barspikes at to get through 2 ends
cutting Mid is latter fresh gale and thick rising
saw plenty of ice. To end three ships in site

Monday 28th

First part fresh breeze and thick rising saw ice
Mid fresh gale and rising saw plenty of ice
Latter fresh gale with rising and saw being three ships
in site

Tuesday May 29th 1835

First moderate gale from the E.S.E. and
thick rising ship on different tracks under close
reefs up sails at 9 A.M. Lighted up started the
works Latter part light airs and thick fog
2 ends

Wednesday 30th

First part light breeze from the S.E. and
thick Mid is latter saw thick the ice in site
and plenty of ships employed in boiling 2 ends

Thursday 31st

First light airs from the Westward. Arriving
to the Eastward at 4 P.M. came in thick left
to Mid is latter part fine weather 2 ends got through boiling

Friday June 1st

First part gentle breeze from the S.E. saw and chest
whales in the ice at 4 p.m. spoke the ship Reindeer
of New Bedford 7 whole this season Mid is latter fine
weather saw finbacks employed in flensing down 2 ends

Saturday 3rd

First part light airs and fine weather in with
the ice saw finbacks Mid is latter fine weather
at 6 A.M. spoke the ship Pocahontas of Isbury
nothing this season 2 ends

Sunday 3rd

First part light airs from the S.E. and saw rising
Mid is latter saw thick several ships in site
