

Remarks On Board Ship Cambridge

Friday July 6th 1833

First part Strong gale from the S.E. and thick
took in the fore sail and abast reef the main
top sail heading to the westward Mid & Latter
much the same were ship to the Eastward
No End

Saturday 7th

First part fresh gale from south and clear heading
to the Eastward Mid & Latter more moderate with
the top sails double reefed saw one ship S.W.

Sunday 8th

First part Strong Breeze from the S.E. and clear
heading on distant track Mid the same Latter fresh
gale took in the top sails saw one ship S.W.

Monday 9th

First part fresh gale from the S.E. and clear heading
to the Westward Mid more moderate with the top sails
Latter Strong Breeze shook out the reefs with the main
top gallant sail & mainsail S.W.

Employed in sheering Bon

Tuesday 10th

First part Strong Breeze from the S.E. and fine
clear weather heading to the S.E.
Mid & Latter part moderate and thick fog
saw a whale to thick to Lower Deck

of Isbury Martha's Vineyard Mys

Wednesday July 11th 1833

First part Light and thick fog
Mid & Latter the same so ends

Thursday 12th

First part Light air and some thick
at 5 saw and abast two whales
Mid & Latter thick saw three whales S.W.
No CB

Friday 13th

First part Light air and thick
Mid & Latter part thick so ends
No CB

Saturday 14th

First part gentle Breeze from the S.E. and fine
at 3 p.m. Sled up saw whales Lower Deck
one got three boats fast to him he run and
saw one boat drawn the whale run to wind
ward at sundown had to cut saw nothing but
his head while fast to him Mid & Latter Strong
Breeze and fine clear weather S.W.

Sunday 15th

First part Strong Breeze and fine clear weather saw
one whale going quick to the Eastward two sails
in site at 6 A.M. spoke the Ship Arab of Barb
harrow 2 Bar head & 1 right whale this season is Corns
Abouland 2 Bow Head Bark Favorite 1 right whale
saw for two whales without success Mid & Latter
part gentle Breeze and fine weather S.W. in site
so ends
