First part strong breeze from the Westward and thick several ship in site. Mid & latter part gentle breeze and thick at 7 A.M. spoke the ship Phoenix of New Bedford. S. Ind. George & Mary of New Bedford & whale. Saw and chert a whale. S. Ind.
